



5th CMAS WORLD CUP 2010

FIN SWIMMING "Golden Finale"

October 2010 from 22nd to 25th - AIX EN PROVENCE - FRANCE

PARTICULAR RULES

- **1 – DESIGNATION:**

The French Underwater Federation, with the C.M.A.S agreement organizes the **Golden Final of the 5th CMAS WORLD CUP 2010 fin swimming.**

- **2 – ORGANIZATION:**

The competition is ruled by the CMAS Finswimming International Rules. Every athlete, with his/her enrolment, affirms to know and to agree to them.

The races are according the rules:

CMAS World Cup program

> **Senior (Cat. A) M/F:** 50ap, 50sf, 100sf, 200sf, 400sf, 800sf, 50bf, 100bf, 200bf, 100im, 4x100 relay.

> **Junior (Cat. B + C + D) G/B:** 50ap (except D), 50sf, 100sf, 200sf, 400sf, 800sf, 50bf, 100bf, 200bf, 100im, 4x100 relay

- **3 – PARTICIPATING:**

- **The club need to send agreement from his national federation.**

- Each club must be associated by a National Federation recognized by C.M.A.S. and each competitor must have the National Federation Licence **and CMAS International Sport Licence.**

- In the CMAS Finswimming World Cup Meeting, only clubs can participate.

- Each competitor can participate for only one (1) club during the year.

- Each competitor can take part in a maximum of three (3) individual races and one (1) relay in World Cup.

- Each team can enrol a maximum of two swimmers for each individual race.

- Each team can take part to only one male and one female relay per category in World Cup.



- **4 – COMPETITION:**

- The competition will take place in :
“Yves Blanc” swimming pool, Aix en Provence
Avenue des Ecoles Militaires
13100 AIX en PROVENCE
- Swimming pool has length 50 meters, 8 lanes.
- Electronic time-keeping “STRAMATEL” executing by FFESSM.

- **5 – ENTRY DATE:**

- Preliminary entry form : before **10th September 2010** (enclosure 1)
- Final entry form : **14th October 2010** (enclosure 2)
- **For the French clubs, enrolments are available only by E-Nap,**
<http://www.e-nap.fr> like all competitions in France.

- **6 – APPLICATION FORM:**

- The preliminary and final form must be received at the following e-mails :
aix2010@e-nap.fr and copy to the C.M.A.S. HQ (spo@cmas.org)

- **7 – ADMINISTRATIVE DOCUMENTS AND EQUIPMENTS CHECKING:**

- Checking will be made in according to the time program.

- **8 – DOPING:**

- Anti-doping control follows C.M.A.S’ rules.

- **9 – CLASSIFICATIONS:**

- Classifications follow C.M.A.S’ rules.

- **10 – AWARDING CEREMONIES AND PRIZES:**

The athletes should be at disposal to organizing staff at the right time, and in according to the time program competition. Prizes wouldn’t give if the swimmers are not present at their awarding ceremonies. During the ceremony, the athletes must wear official uniform of their club.

Round

- Individual prizes:
 - ▲ Medals to the first, second and third classified in each individual race and relays.
- Club prizes:
 - ▲ Cup for clubs’ classification.

Golden Final

According point 4 of CMAS World Cup rules.



- **11 – HOTELS, CATERING, TRANSFERS :**

- The association France Sport Association is delegate by the National Fin Swimming Committee of the FFESSM to organize transfers, booking and catering during the competition. The catering will be taken near the swimming pool, avoid transportations to the hotels during the day. All information can be found in the enclosed documents.
- **This round is the finale and requires placing a ceremony and musical gala buffet. So, the clubs wish to attend themselves to their hotel and catering and do not take advantage of France Sport Association services for the residence, will pay 20€ (Euros) to fee per person. This sum will be pay to France Sport Association to the arrival.**

- **12 – COMPETITION FEE :**

- Competition fees are :
 - **30€ per team, 10€ per distance and 10€ per relay.**

- **13 – VARIOUS :**

- Protests follow C.M.A.S' rules.
- Organization committee reserve the right for any change in the program.
- After 15th October, a 50€ (Euros) fee will be paid to the organizer for swimmer declared withdrawal.

- **14 – NATIONAL FLAG**

- We kindly ask each team to bring with them one flag with an approximate size of 2m x 1m
