The warming-up will start at 08:45 in the morning session and at 15:00 in the afternoon session.





7.- CATEGORIES: There is only one categorie per sex. ABSOLUTE.

8.- PARTICIPATION:

- All swimmers must be in possession of a valid CMAS and national licences for finswimming. The organization will control all swimmers valid licences in the reception of participants.
- Delegates and coaches must be federated.
- Each swimmer may take part in three individual events, plus the relay.
- Each team may enter a maximum of 12 swimmers.
- **9.- CONTROL:** The development of the competition will be controlled by the Territorial Referees' Committee from EHUIF, who will designate the Competition Judges.
- **10.- COMPETITION EQUIPMENT:** All the equipment used in the competition must comply with the CMAS Competition Regulations. The committee will check equipment in the reception of participants.
- **11.- PROVISION OF LOADS FOR IMMERSION TANKS:** The organization will facilitate the filling of the tanks to a max. pressure of 200 Atm. Any tank out of marked control date (3 years) will not be filled. The cylinders to be used during competition must be delivered to the organization on Friday the 25 of February from 18:00 to 21:00 h.

12.-SCORING: The CMAS table adapted for the 25m pool Ordizia records will be used as reference. The 100m Bifins reces will not be scored for this year due to the absent of records.

- **13.- CLASSIFICATIONS:** The competitors will be ranked individually according to the scoring results.
- **14.- PRIZES:** From all the races for each swimmer, the race with highest score will be considered. In this way the first three men and women will be awarded with a trophy.

All participant teams will receive a gift.

15.- PARTICIPANT RECEPTION: The participants' reception will be hold in the Ordizia council swimming pool (Majori Sports Center) on Friday the 25 of February from 18:00 to 21:00 h. During this period of time, two lanes will be available for training.





16.- INSCRIPTION:

- The **Preliminary inscription** must be sent to the organizer before the 29 of January 2011 (annexe 1).
- The **final inscription** must be sent to the organizer before the 5 of february 2011 (annex 2).

17.- ORGANIZATION RIGHTS: The organisation reserves the right to modify the competition program, due to justified reasons, the order of programmed events, as well as the cancellation of these events, previous report of the Basque Committee of Finswimming and its communication to the delegates of each team.

Each team will carry out the warming-up in the assigned lanes and time determined by the organization.

Everything which is not gathered in this Particular Regulation, will be subject to the Regulation of Finswimming of C.M.A.S. in force.
