

1- GENERAL INFORMATION

The competition will take place in Hódmezővásárhely - Hungary from Thursday 28th of July to Sunday 7th of August 2011.



The City of Hódmezővásárhely

- situated in the Southern part of Hungary
- pool with thermal water
- 1 and $\frac{3}{4}$ of an hour from Budapest on highway

2- THE POOL

Indoor swimming pool, length 50 meters, 10 lanes, depth 2,20 m., temperature $26^{\circ}\text{C} \pm 1^{\circ}\text{C}$, electronic scoreboard, 700 spectators' seats



4- PARTICIPATION

Eligible to participate at this Championship are the teams of National Federations, affiliated to CMAS. Each National team should comply with the Championship Rules, Safety Requirements set by the Organizers and all other CMAS Rules and Regulations.

Swimmingpool events: Each national team should enter not more than two (2) competitors to each individual event and not more than one team to each relay.

Long Distance events: Each national team should enter not more than four (4) competitors to each individual event and not more than one team to the relay.

National teams should bring two (2) national flags (m. 2,00 x m. 1,00) and a CD with the national anthem.

9- CYLINDERS/BOTTLES FILLING

The organizer guarantees the filling of cylinders/bottles, be it either DIN or YOKE type. Maximum charging pressure is 200 Bars. All cylinders/bottles must be in good condition and must have passed a hydraulic test not more than 24 month before the date of the championship.

- Participation at the opening ceremony
- Free transportation Budapest – Hódmezővásárhely –Budapest
(Airport-Hotel-Airport)

> **Choice 3 (6 days):** Entry fee for each participant is **540 Euro**. The organizer will provide:

- Accommodations in hotel with rooms of two, three or four beds.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, beginning with the dinner of the **2nd of August** until the breakfast of the **7th of August 2011**.
- Transportation between hotel and lake
- Participation at the closing ceremony
- Free transportation Budapest – Hódmezővásárhely –Budapest
(Airport-Hotel-Airport)

Extra charges for single room is 40 Euro per day.

Extra day expenses 75 Euro per extra day, including 3 meals and accommodation.

11- SECRETARY AND COMPETITION FEE

Participants wishing to organise their own accommodation are welcome to do so. In this case a **350 Euro**/person competition fee should be paid for organization, secretary, competition, opening and closing ceremonies. No local transportation will be provided.

12- VISA

If you need visas please contact the nearest Hungarian Embassy or Consular Office to your country of residence. In order to facilitate the visa process please send copies of the cover- and title (1.) pages of your passport on time to the Hungarian Divers Federation e-mail address buvar@buvar.hu, so we can supply to the necessary invitation letters. Visa arrangements should start not later than 30 days prior to entry into Hungary.

13- OTHER

Electrical current in Hungary is 220V, 50Hz.

14- DEADLINE, CONDITION FOR ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION

- **no later than 1st May 2011**
 - **(Annex 1)** The preliminary declaration of participation and registration form to the CMAS and Organizing Committee in Hungary should be sent.
 - **(Annex 2)** Preliminary Hotel Booking form and entry fee to the Organizing Committee in Hungary has to be sent.
 - **(Annex 3)** The letter proving the bank transfer should be sent to the Organizing Committee
- **no later than 15th June 2011**
 - **(Annex 4)** Competitor's List has to be sent to CMAS HQ.
 - **(Annex 5)** Hotel Booking period is closed, Final Booking List has to be sent to the Organizing Committee in Hungary.
 - Participation declaration and bookings after the above indicated date would carry a 15% surcharge. We are calling all federations to

observe this second deadline as hotels in the area are servicing tourism in the peak season, so the surcharge will be strictly applied.
