2. General Information

2.1 Background on Eger, Hungary

The Underwater Hockey World Championship will take place in the pools of Eger, Heves County - Hungary from Friday, the 23rd August to Sunday 1st September 2013.

To get an idea of the whereabouts of this 60 000+ inhabitants town in North-Eastern Hungary, - 130 kilometres away from Budapest airport, - please refer to the map below.



Eger with its one thousand-year history, heroic past, rich monuments, good food, unique spa is the second most visited sight of Hungary. The town is a historic place, yet it is also noted for its splendid Baroque architecture, wine, thermal and medicinal waters and lively student population. It became an Episcopal seat as early as the 11th century during the reign of St. Stephen, the state-founding king of Hungary. Disaster struck the town many times. It was practically destroyed during the invasion of the Tatars, but its fortress, built in the 13th century played a major role in the defence during the wars with the Othman Empire when in 1552 Captain István Dobó and a handful of his soldiers withstood the attack of the huge Turkish army. History does not remember that, but the early October snowfall helped the defenders greatly.



The centre of Eger is dominated by its magnificent Baroque palaces, public buildings and of course by the Lyceum. It became an important cultural and education centre in the 18th century. Close to 200 outstanding examples of the architecture of the past few



centuries have been preserved in their original forms. The Eger Castle and fortification, castle museum, casemate, Gothic Palace, gallery, the Basilica from 1836, the Archbishop's Palace, Lyceum and its magnificent Library, Observatory and periscope, "Minor" Provost's Palace, Santa Clara Grammar School, Franciscan Church, County Hall from 1756, wrought iron gate by Henrik Fazola from 1778, the unique Sports Museum, "Major" Provost's Palace, County

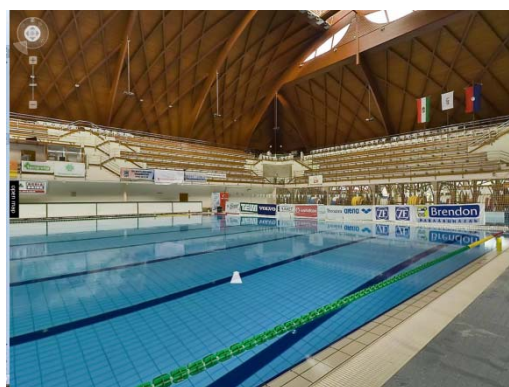
Library from 1722, or the Minorite Church from 1773, the unique in Central Europe Minaret from 1624 the Servite Church from 1752, the Greek-Orthodox Church and Orthodox parsonage are just a few of the cultural highlites of the town. The Kepes Museum, the István Dobó Grammar School, Cistercian Church and Grammar School, the Telekessy Pharmacy Museum with crockery, and Centre for Archbishop's Collection are also among the "must be sees" of the place.

Town and it's surroundings are well-known for its wines. For over 1,000 years the population of the region produced grapes and excellent wines, such as Egri Bikavér (Bull's Blood) and Egri Leányka (Maiden of Eger, or the Rizling). The oldest wine-cellar are more than 400 years old (Szépasszonyvölgy), but new ones are carved into the volcanic ash mountains to this day.

Thermal springs were discovered in the 15th century. Since those times Eger is a frequented spa for visitors from neighbouring countries and from faraway places as well. Many public baths were in operation already during the Turkish era. The rebuilt Bath of Pasha Arnaut, or the Turkish Bath, is still open for those seeking treatment.

2.2 “ Bitskey Aladár” Indoor Pool and “Strand” Open Pools

The Underwater Hockey World Championship will have two pools, one indoor and one open air swimming pool. The Bitskey Aladár indoor swimming pool is a 50 meters long pool, with width of 21 meters, depth 2,20 m., temperature of the water is 28° C ± 1° C, with electronic scoreboard and has 1 700 spectators' seats. It was built in 2003 and is the most spectacular pool of the country, hosting international swimming competitions, water polo tournaments, as well as many international underwater activities' training camps. The 2012 Finswimming World Cup and Euro Party took place in this magnificent pool of Eger.

The open air pool is a new facility, built three years ago in the open air public pools area of the town. It is 3 minutes walk from the indoor pool. World Championship designated (BB) hotels are in a radius of 500 meters, where two of the hotels are even bordering the pools' grounds. (Aqua Hotel and Hotel Flora).



Relax tent and internet transmission centre, as well as internet facilities for the athletes would be established on these grounds. General public would be able to view matches on the two scoreboards.

2.3 Visa Requirements

If you require visas please contact the nearest Hungarian Embassy or Consular Office to your country of residence. In order to facilitate the visa process please send list of participants with names, birth dates and passport numbers to the tournament e-mail address to info@buvar.hu, as soon as you would know your teams' player names and accompanying persons, we can supply you with the necessary invitation letters. Visa arrangements should start not later than three months prior to entry into Hungary.

2.4 Additional Information

The official currency of Hungary is the Hungarian Forint (HUF). At the moment the ongoing exchange rate is 1 €=280HUF and 1 USD=223HUF

Hungary follows the left hand drive system.

The metrical measure system is used in Hungary.

Electrical current in Hungary is 220V, 50Hz, plug is two-pin round shape.

3.2 Rules

The event is organised under the following rules and guidelines:

3.3 Tournament Divisions

Each national federation can enter up to 4 women's and 4 men's teams. The divisions are as follows:

All athletes, referees and team officials must possess a valid CMAS license.



3.4 Player Selection and Replacement

Teams are limited to 12 players and must be selected before the submission of the team list and player profiles on the 30th June 2013. Players may be replaced between the 30 June and tournament registration on medical grounds only. This provision is to limit the increased workload on volunteer organisers that swapping players.

3.5 Playing Cap and Swimsuit approvals

These requests must be submitted to the Tournament Director by email before 30th April 2013, to: uweworlds2013@buvar.hu. Please use **Cap and Swimsuit Approval Request** in your email request subject line.

As per Clause 11.2.1 All players of a team must wear identical bathing attire (suit and/or rash vest and/or shirt), which may have an imprint of their flag or country. Each team must have two sets of identical bathing attire, one light in colour (when the team is using white sticks) and one dark in colour (when the team is using black sticks), and both sets need Tournament Director approval prior to arrival at the competition.

Light Colours: White, Yellow, Light Blue, Light Grey, Orange.

Dark Colours: Black, Blue, Royal Blue, Navy Blue, Grey, Brown, Green, Red

Cap Numbers: To assist referees, cap numbers are limited to numbers between 1 and 15.

3.6 Additional Training Space

Teams that wish to arrive earlier than the allocated orientation and training days are welcome to do so from the 16th August 2013. Three lanes in the open air pool have been secured for teams and evening training matches could be played from 7 pm to 8:30 and from 8:30 to 10 pm in the whole pool. Charges to be paid by the teams are:

- ▶ Full open air pool price is Euro 110/hour between 16th to the 20th August, each day from 7pm to 10pm.
- ▶ Lane price in the open air pool is Euro 5/hour/person. Three lanes are secured from the 16th to the 20th August

3.7 Registration and Meetings

Registration, documents check and delivery of accreditation will be undertaken at the indoor swimming pool for all teams. The various meetings will be held at the indoor pool conference room.

3.8 Opening Ceremony

Opening ceremony of the CMAS Underwater Hockey World Championship will be held on the 22nd August at 18:00 p.m. in front of Hotel Eger & Park after which the Mayor's reception will be hosted at Town Hall for the team leaders of the World Championship.

3.9 Awards and Closing Ceremony

Awards and closing ceremony of the World Championship will be held on the 31st August at 19:00 pm. at the Indoor Pool at the conclusion of the finals.

3.10 Post Event Celebration

"Gulyás Party and Wine tasting" will be held at the Town Cellars at 20:30 pm on Saturday 31st August 2013. Fourteen tickets per team entry fee have been provided.



3.11 Departure

Sunday 1st September 2013* - Departure of the delegations, transfer to Liszt Ferenc international airport in Budapest

3.12 World Championship Puck

According to mandatorily public procurement practices, the Hungarian Divers Federation under the Hungarian Olympic Committee, are required to tender the supply of pucks for the competition. This will be published by 30th July with closing date for receipt of pucks and documentation by 1st October for the evaluation.

Suppliers will need to send 4 non-returnable pucks to the Hungarian Divers Federation, H- 1134 Budapest, Dózsa Gy. út 53. , as well as supply documentation and guarantees. All costs in the evaluation are borne by the supplier. A tender document will be supplied to suppliers who register their interest via email to: uwhworlds2013@buvar.hu

The most suitable pucks would have to be chosen giving the best performance on the tiles of the pools. A special training/testing session by players will be held in the presence of the President of the Underwater Hockey Commission and the International Chief Judge of the tournament. The pucks will be evaluated and the best performing puck will be selected.

The World Championship puck evaluation result will be announced on 10th December 2012.



4. Officials

4.1 Tournament Officials

- International Chief Judge:** Tristan Reynard, New Zealand
- Tournament Referees:** Appointed once referees attendance is confirmed.
Two to be appointed.
- Tournament Jury:** Appointed once referees attending is confirmed.
Number of members as according to CMAS Rules
- Grading of Referees:** This will be undertaken by no less than 5 Senior International Referees from separate federations by peer review.

4.2 Referees

Each team must supply one qualified water referee. The tournament needs 48 suitable water referees to successfully officiate 4 matches at once.

All Referees must pass the referee in water beep test in Eger, at the start of the tournament to be graded as Level 1, 2 or 3.

Deck only referees are welcome to attend however Deck Referees will be graded and feedback given but no referee grading will be provided as all criteria will not be assessed.

4.3 Referee Accommodation

Full board for the referees staying at the referee hotel will be provided. If Referees chose to stay with their teams they will have their board covered by their own team.

4.4 Referee Grading

Based on performance referees will be graded as follows:

5. Team Entry Fees

5.1 CMAS Registration

5.2 CMAS Licences

All officials, coaches, athletes, referees, medical staff etc. are required to have their valid CMAS licences in order to be able to enter with their teams to the competition area.

5.3 Tournament Entry Fee

Teams participating at the World Championship are required to bring a Level 3 water referee and pay Euro 1995 per team*.

Note: * Teams bringing a L2 water referee will have to pay an additional Euro 500/team, for teams with a L1 referee this cost will be Euro 700. Teams not bringing referees at all will have to pay an additional Euro 1000. However, these supplementary payments for the non-supply of qualified referees will be done at the Tournament Office in Eger after the beep test of the Chief Judge and Tournament Director. Teams that fail to pay the supplementary payment will be disqualified.

The team entry fee covers the following costs:

- ▶ organising Committee's 16 months expenses, (transport, telecommunication, volunteers' maintenance costs etc.), related exclusively to the preparation of the World Championship
- ▶ team-leaders' opening welcome reception at town hall
- ▶ open air pool for two training days (21st and 22nd August)
- ▶ two pools for 9 competition days (23rd to 31st August)
- ▶ server for the online transmission
- ▶ four broad band high speed internet connections brought to the pool sides for the online transmission
- ▶ LED panels at the pools, tent at the open air swimming pool
- ▶ volunteers' assistance throughout the World Championship
- ▶ underwater cameras and underwater sound system
- ▶ online-real time transmission through the CMAS website www.cmas.org
- ▶ first aid, medical service presence
- ▶ anti doping tests' costs
- ▶ security service
- ▶ bottles and bottles filling for the judges



- ▶ DVD of the Championship
- ▶ internet connection at the pools sides for the athletes (high speed, board band WIFI)
- ▶ participation at the opening, closing ceremonies
- ▶ closing "Gulyás Party" and wine tasting for 14 people per team. Additional persons cost Euro 50/person

6. Accommodation

Eger is a major tourist destination. Just like in other countries and tourist destinations in Europe and elsewhere in the world during high season, hotel prices in Eger at this time are higher than published prices, due to the high demand. According to preliminary figures, the World Championship will see around 1 200 athletes, plus the accompanying fans and family members.

The town has approximately 5,500 beds accommodation capacity, including private houses accommodation. On the basis of long term agreements about 40% of the facilities are already booked in the previous year.

To secure sufficient accommodation options and quality, the Underwater Hockey World Championship organisers have been required to book at least 50% of all the qualifying hotel space. This has been done and hoteliers gave the Championship a most favourable pricing structure, so all teams would have secured, pre-booked, good quality accommodation and superb food. The goal is to satisfy all participants' needs and budgets.

Organisers discourage teams to resorting to direct booking as quality will not be assured, availability in the very last moment could easily be changed and prices would definitely not be as competitive as prices achieved by the Organising Committee of the Hungarian Divers Federation one and half year before the tournament. For accommodation not obtained through the Hungarian Divers Federation, organisers cannot and will not assume any responsibility.

In case you would like to organise Airport-Eger-Airport transport yourself, calculate with 170 USD return trip of the taxi of which you need two. One at arrival one at departure.

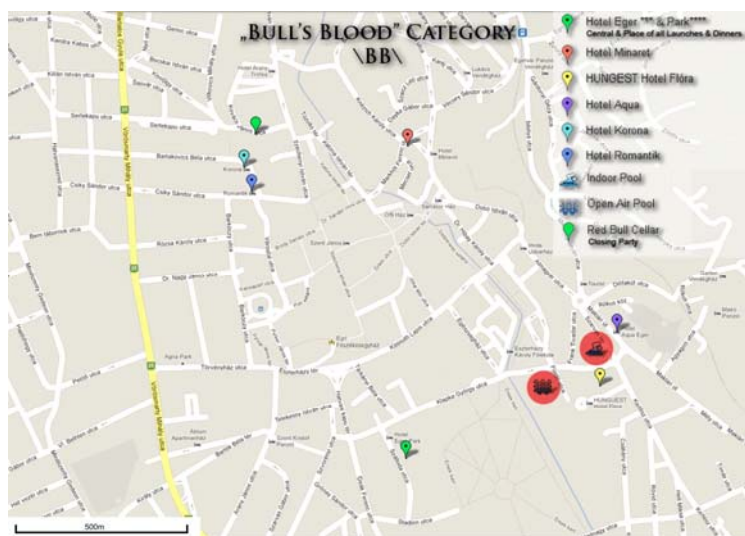
Due to luggages most probably 3 people will fit in the taxi, eventually 4.
This way the Eger-Airport-Eger transport cost would be in the tune of 85-113 USD/person.

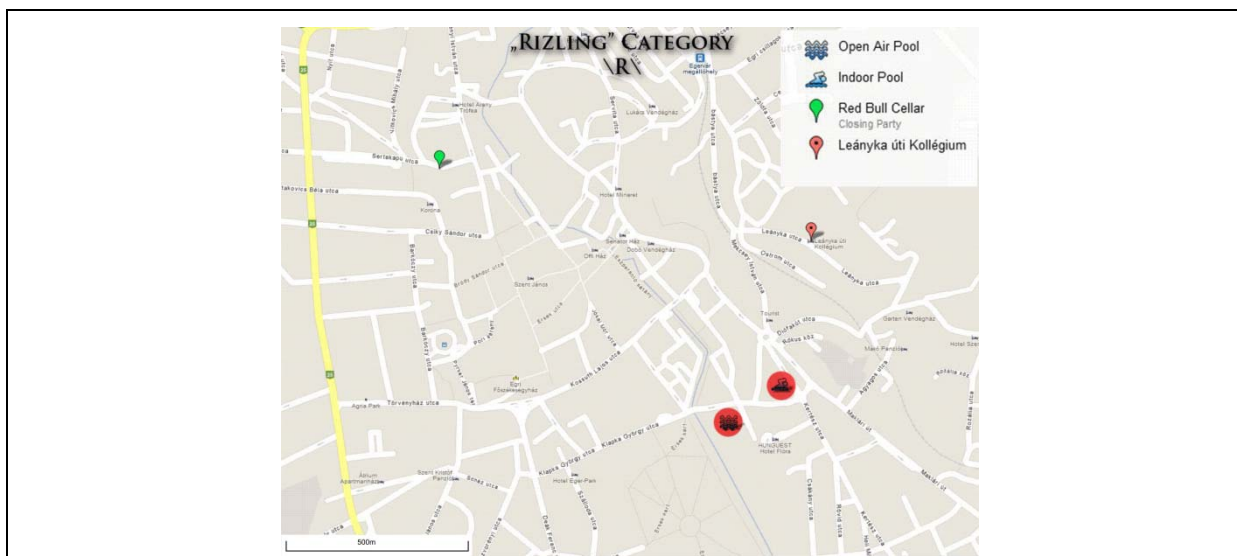
