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1. CLOC

1.1 Official Logo

The emblem for The World Games 2013 Cali logo is the ribbon. It represents the constant joy and movement of Cali. Blue, red and green are the colors of our city flag that enhances the glory, passion and strength that athletes will have in their soul, making our hearts vibrate with excitement.



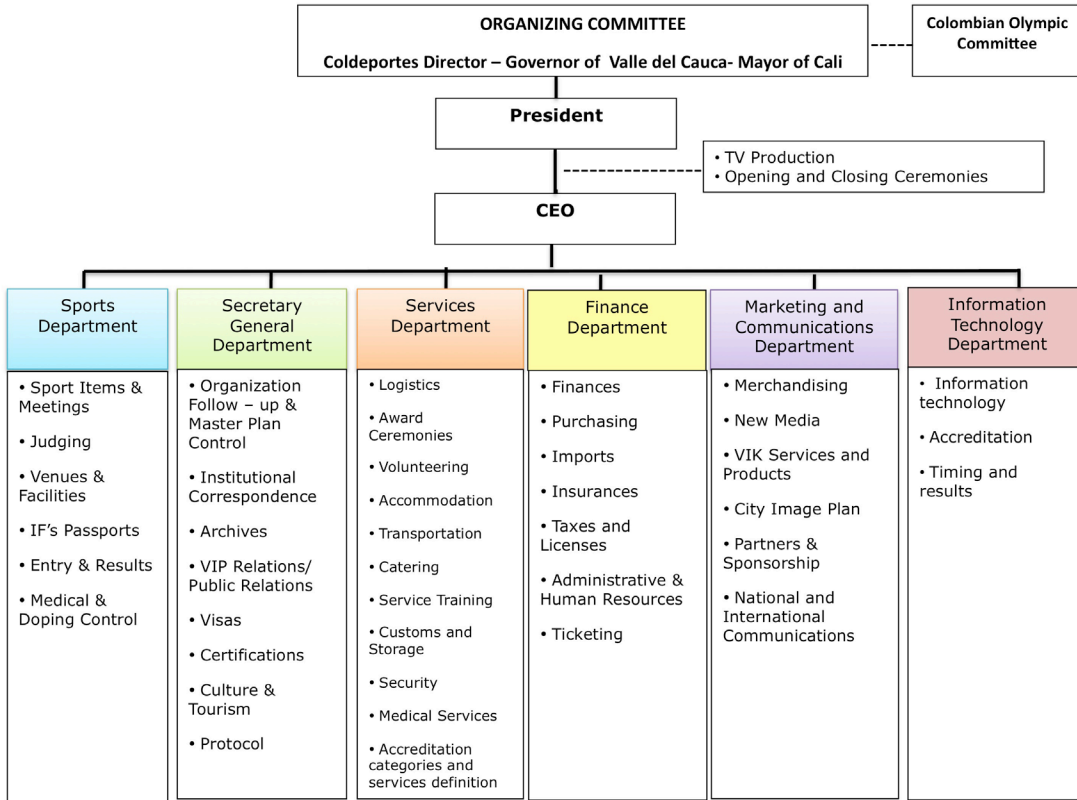
Blue, red and green are the colors of the air, water, fire and the land that gave us birth. Yellow is the light of our sun, the gold that will light up our victories in each competition. Black represents the great African heritage, a legacy of cultural diversity.

1.3 Anti-Doping Program

- 1.3.1 Supervising Organization – According to IWGA (International World Games Association) Anti-Doping rules, the IWGA is the governing body to supervise anti-doping regulations. Upon accepting participation, each athlete of the International Federation must comply with any and all testing requirements of IWGA anti-doping standards. The final anti-doping program is at the discretion of the IWGA Medical Commission.
- 1.3.2 CLOC Responsibility – CLOC is responsible for following the standards set forth by the World Anti-Doping Association (WADA), and must ensure that anti-doping tests are conducted properly.
- 1.3.3 COLDEPORTES Responsibility – CLOC has selected COLDEPORTES as being the party responsible to conduct and implement anti-doping procedures. They will also provide the laboratory.
- 1.3.4 Anti-Doping Control Center – In accordance with the IWGA Medical Commission, an anti-doping control center, or control centers will be established to make sure that all anti-doping requirements are carried out and all standards met.
- 1.3.5 IWGA Medical Commission – The IWGA Medical Commission will actualize the anti-doping program. The WADA accredited laboratory in Bogota, Colombia will analyze tests.

2. Accreditation

2.1 Accreditation Milestones

An electronic package will be sent out to all IF Secretaries General on January 20, 2013, that will contain an introduction letter, a formatted excel spreadsheet, relevant forms, and an instruction manual with detailed information about the system and process.

CLOC's accreditation department will start accepting accreditation data from the Secretaries General starting February 1 through June 30. Please make sure to send the formatted spreadsheets prior to the deadline. Our team will upload all the information to the system provided to us on an ongoing basis during that timeline.

This procedure was introduced and explained in our meeting in November.

On June 1st, the accreditation system will open in order that each IF Secretary General can validate, edit, and make any revisions needed to their delegation. You will be provided with a link, username, and password in order to gain access. The system will be open to you with limited features, and for a limited time period. It will close on June 30th. Any exceptions to this process and these dates will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

Production of the IACs (Identity Accreditation Card) will begin in June. All IACs will be available for pickup from the Accreditation Center. When you arrive at the airport in Cali, a volunteer and shuttle will be there to greet all delegates, and accompany them to the accreditation center, a short ride away.



At the center, you will be provided with your IAC by the accreditation staff. Please be sure to keep your identification handy, as it will be required for you to receive your IAC.

The accreditation center, and an alternative accreditation center will be open for the games duration, July 25 to August 4, in case there is a need for a replacement IAC. Information about the alternative accreditation center will be detailed in Bulletin 3.

The list of accreditation forms will be in bulletin No 3.

2.2 Extra Officials and Pre-Payment

Extra Officials are one of the three categories of people who must go through the accreditation process, but are considered “Extra” because they exceed the number of persons an International Federation is allowed under the contract between CLOC and IWGA.

The International Federation is responsible for their meals, hotel accommodation, transportation, and an administrative fee to be paid to CLOC for the accredited period in advance, USD \$55.

Please note: If payment is not confirmed by CLOC, the IAC will not be issued to the party concerned.

Two payment forms will be accepted, bank wire transfer and credit card (Visa, MasterCard). Payment deadlines are as follows:

1. Online Accreditation for Extra Official (15/3/2013)
2. 50% Guarantee Deposit (15/3/2013)
3. Payment of Balance (15/5/2013)
4. Replacement/Substitute Extra Official (15/5/2013)

How Much and what is covered? Each International Federation needs to submit payment for the Extra Official to CLOC. The fee below is calculated based on a Peso to dollar exchange rate as of October 2012. This real rate will be based on the date that the fee is paid.

CP \$295.000= (approximately USD\$ 162 per day)

This includes a double occupancy room, 3 meals a day, ground transportation, airport shuttle, and an administrative fee.

The process and instructions for extra official payment will be detailed in the letter



acompanying the electronic accreditation package.

2.3 Accredited Period

Persons listed below on an IF Passport are eligible to receive services from CLOC on service dates of their respective sport:

1. Athletes
2. Officials
3. Extra Officials

If the plans include dates before the day of check-in or later than the day of check-out, costs (including meals, accommodations, and transportation) should be arranged and paid for by the individual. More details on this will be provided in the following Bulletin.

2.4 Accreditation Center

The accreditation center will provide services such as verification, delivery, and re-issue of the IAC for Athletes, Officials, Extra Officials that are eligible for services based on the IF Passport.

They will also serve this purpose for any CLOC members, staff, and volunteers.

The accreditation center will be located at the Centro de Convenciones Valle del Pacifico. After you pass through customs and immigration, there will be signs and volunteers outside the luggage pick-up area directing you to the shuttles that will take you to the accreditation center. You should only let yourself be accompanied with official volunteers who will be recognizable by their IAC and uniform.

There will be one main accreditation center and an additional one for locals and eventualities which location will be confirmed in a later date.

2.5 Entry Visa

CLOC is currently working with governmental agencies to make passing through customs and immigration easier whether you need a visa or not. Specific steps on clearing customs and immigration will be provided in the next bulletin and will be posted on the webpage of The World Games 2013 Cali. In the meantime, please refer to Appendix A for a list of countries who are exempt from the Visa process, and those countries which citizens need a visa in order to enter Colombia, as well as a direct link to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' website.

Arrangements have been made so that one of the customs and immigration's check points will be designated for The World Games.

4. Press and Media Work

- 4.1 Press and Media Center – will be located in a strategic point of the city, near to the hotels and venues. The center will be around 2000 square meters.

The technical zone will include a studio, TOC (Technical Operation Center), and postproduction areas, as well as work space. The administrative zone will include offices, meeting rooms, a reception area, production facilities, and general logistics facilities.

Specific details relating to the IBC (International Broadcast Center), MPC (Media and Press Center), host broadcaster and information about production planning will be provided in Bulletin 3.

- 4.2 International Rights - IWGA has selected UFA Sports to handle all international media and commercial rights for both The World Games 2013 Cali and The World Games 2017 Wroclaw.

IWGA will use UFA's expertise in international sports marketing in order to sell corporate sponsorship, strengthen brand identities, and maximize the visibility of The World Games broadcast coverage.

UFA Sports is an industry leader in sports marketing. Some of its clients include FIFA, DFB (Deutscher Fußball-Bund /German Football Association), and other well recognized sports' brands.

- 4.3 Media Accreditation - Accreditation for journalists, photographers, and all other media will take place parallel to the standard accreditation process with a few small differences. An online application will be available for the press/media organization or individual. The following is a timeline of milestones that the process will follow.

Applications will be sent to all media outlets or individuals that have expressed interest in covering The World Games 2013 Cali. CLOC has been compiling a database of individuals that have shown interest in covering the Games. Requests for applications will be accepted through April 30, 2013. Any requests received after this deadline will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

Once an application has been approved, a notification will be sent out to the organization, which contains a brief description of how the process works, and the tools needed to proceed.

All information needed for accreditation should needs to be returned to CLOC by May 31, 2013. Only official registered press will receive an accreditation.

Once all information has been compiled and validated, it will go into production. Production will run from June 1 to August 4. While the accreditation center opens on July 15, IAC for local media (or upon special request) will be available through an alternative distribution point before the center opens.

The alternative distribution point will be used to produce and distribute replacement IACs as well.

6 Services

6.1 Accommodations

- 6.1.1 Hotels – Arrangements have been made with 35 hotels to accommodate all athletes, delegates, and VIPs attending The World Games 2013 Cali. The allocation of the hotels will be done by sport and discipline. In Bulletin No. 3, we will be announcing the names of the hotels assigned to each sport.
- 6.1.2 Venue Proximity – Hotel selection will be prioritized by proximity to the venue. This is done in keeping with IWGA guidelines in order to minimize transportation time to and from the competition and training facilities.
- 6.1.3 Allocation made by International Federations – The rooms will be reserved by the CLOC, but the IF will assign the rooms to anyone covered under the IF Passport. Due to the limitation of accommodations in Cali, rooms will be 2 people per room with very few exceptions.
- 6.1.4 What's covered? – For all those staying under the CLOC – IWGA agreement, the room and the breakfast are the only items that are covered. Anything such as mini-bar, pay per view television, telephone charges, and laundry are not covered under this agreement. Once you have been assigned a hotel, you can refer to their policy for details. This will be communicated to all hotels.

6.2 Transportation

- 6.2.1 International Arrival – When travelling from abroad, you can fly directly to Cali or arrive to Bogotá or Medellín and take a flight to Cali from there. Cali's airport is Alfonso Bonilla Aragon International Airport and it is located about 30 minutes drive from Cali.
- 6.2.2 The CLOC will be providing shuttles from the Airport to the accreditation center and hotels for all travelers covered under the IF Passport. The shuttle will have no specific luggage and carry- on limitations, so if you follow the airline regulations you should be fine. Any additional items should be cleared with the CLOC in advance.



6.2.3 Venue Service – Shuttles are also being contracted in order to transport IF Passport holders between the hotels, venues, and the Cultural Plaza in downtown Cali. As these shuttles are specifically for IF Passport holders, make sure you have your IAC with you, in order to avoid any inconveniences. There will be an English speaking volunteer on each shuttle in order to clarify any questions that you may have. Detailed information about airport, venue, hotel, and cultural plaza transportation services will be provided in Bulletin No. 3.

6.3 Service Volunteers – Volunteers will be found everywhere you can think of while The World Games 2013 Cali is in progress. They will be at the airport, the hotels, the venues, and will be providing anything from translation services to anti-doping assistance. They will be very visible by their uniform and IAC badge. In the next bulletin, we will provide a picture of the uniform and volunteer badge so that you can easily identify them upon your arrival at the airport, hotel, or venue.

6.4 Health Insurance/ First Aid / Medical Services/ FICS

6.4.1 Medical Health Insurance Coverage - Proof of medical health insurance is required under IWGA guidelines in order to be able to receive your IAC card, receive any of the services provided, or compete in any competitions. Purchase of a policy that covers all requirements will be made available through a local provider, Suramericana S.A. The fee of this policy is USD \$ 40 dollars. See appendix D.

It is very important that every athlete carry the required and accepted insurance. It is also recommended to carry insurance purchased through a local provider.

This will save time, and paperwork, being reimbursed from a carrier not accepted here in Colombia.

6.4.2 First Aid Stations – First aid stations will be positioned throughout all the venues where athletes will be competing. Stations will be manned with an ambulance, a medic, 2 nurses, 2 stretcher personnel, and an ambulance driver. Coordination has been made with local hospitals to accept any injured persons during The Games. Any medication administered to athletes will be strictly for emergency, and will be at the discretion of the First Aid personnel.



The Stands – First aid personnel will also be passing through all sections of the venue in case any emergency medical needs arise for spectators.

At your Hotel – Hotels will have a list of ambulance providers in order to take any injured parties to the closest hospital. A phone number for assistance by a volunteer to aid with translation will be provided to the Secretaries General in the case the emergency occurs outside of normal volunteer operating hours (a volunteer will be on location at all hotels during normal volunteer hours).

- 6.4.3 Medical Services – The CLOC will provide First Aid and Emergency Medical services on site at the venue given that the attention needed is as a result of competition related activity. On the off chance that the athlete or person needs to be transmitted to, and treated by, a hospital, the athlete will be responsible for his or her own expenses.
- 6.4.4 FICS – The service by FICS during The World Games 2013 Cali will be available to athletes and delegates based on the agreement between FICS, IWGA, and CLOC.

FICS supports WADA's principles, does not perform any invasive procedures, and does not prescribe any prescription medication. More specific information about FICS services will be made available in subsequent bulletins.

7. Ticketing

Ticket prices and outlets are being negotiated at the moment, and more information will be available soon through our website and Bulletin No. 3.

8. Equipment

- 8.1 With the exception of athletes personal equipment, the CLOC has purchased equipment during the test events, and is in the process of purchasing all required equipment for The World Games. Additional information will be available in bulletin 3.



DB Schenker and Sunrise Cargo are associated as the official freight forwarder and customs broker to The World Games 2013 Cali, Colombia. Complete services information in appendix C.

9. Tourism

9.1 Travel Partner - VIP Sportstravel, AG will be the exclusive travel partner of The World Games 2013 Cali. No other providers outside of Colombia will be considered a travel partner company. Information about VIP Sportstravel packages will be available at The World Games 2013 Cali homepage.

9.2 Helpful Hints

Tourism in Cali is like in most big cities. There are some cultural differences that might be helpful to understand before you arrive. We will provide you with a series of “hints” that we think will be helpful during your stay here.

- Taxis – There are a number of taxi services here in Cali that offer secure drivers. If you are staying at a hotel, they will most likely have a stand with preferred taxis. If there isn’t a stand at your hotel, ask the front desk to call one for you. If you are out and about and need a taxi, try looking for a shopping center or hotel nearby, as they often have a service registered with their business.

- Traffic – Driving in Cali can be interesting. If you plan on renting a car, several companies in Cali have a good plan for you to enjoy the city.

9.3 Cultural Events

Cali is a city that is active in the arts. There are several theaters and museums that are open year round and provide everything from pre- Colombian art to contemporary dance exhibitions.

Cali is also the known as the capital of Salsa. There are a number of instillations that provide shows year round, as well as those that move from venue to venue. When you are in Cali it is recommended to take in one of the many salsa shows available. There are also many small schools that operate informally throughout town.



9.4 The World Games Plaza

The Plaza is located in the center of the city, close to the main hotels and restaurants. There will be a special cultural event every day:

9.5 Tour Ideas

Cali is centrally located in many aspects. It is a short drive to Pacific Ocean, which is popular for whale watching (seasonal), fishing, and eco- tours along the many remote beaches that can be found just a short boat- ride from Colombia’s largest port city, Buenaventura.

Also very close is the “Eje Cafetero”, which is the heart of Colombia’s coffee producing region. It is known as the coffee triangle as well, since the area joins the three states of Risaralda, Quindio, and Caldas. It’s lush landscape, and temperate climate offer the visitor a refreshing escape from the heat of Cali.

A short drive away is Popayan. This town is well-known because of its beautiful colonial architecture and its contributions to Colombian cultural and political life. It is also known as the “white city” due to the color of the most of colonial houses and places in the city downtown, where several churches are located, such as San Francisco, San José, Belén, Santo Domingo, San Agustín, and the Catedral Basílica Nuestra Señora de la Asunción, known locally as “La Catedral”.

They will also be working with CLOC on delivery requirements to venues, hotels, and other locations around the city of Cali.

If you chose to work with another forwarder, please make sure they understand the clearance process and delivery process in Cali for The World Games as these are very different from general shipping processes.

- For DDP, DDU (now DAT, DAP) and CIF shipments the value of cargo, freight, additional charges and insurance has to be duly specified in the invoice.
- Exporter's signature and stamp.
- Currency
- "Proforma" invoice for clearance is not allowed
- Copies for clearance is not allowed
- Commercial invoice to be issued in English and/or Spanish

**Packing List

A packing list shall contain:

- Quantity of goods;
- Quantity and kind of packages (boxes, bags, etc.);
- Dimensions of packages;
- Number of items in each package;
- Unitary detailed description of goods;
- Total net and gross weight;
- Unitary net weight (if possible);
- Serial numbers;
- If "sets", statements how many pieces make up a set;
- Exporter's signature and stamp.
- Copies for clearance is not allowed
- To be issued in English and/or Spanish

***Insurance certificate

If an insurance certificate is issued, it's mandatory to show the insurance premium.

If you are sending donations, please contact DB Schenker office at origin for complete instructions on processing documents and customs procedures, as they are specific for importing into Colombia.

VI. Wood Packing -

Cargo arriving at destination have to comply with the requirements for wood packaging under ISPM15, i.e.:



APPENDIX C

1. All wooden packaging must be bark free.
2. All wooden packaging must have been subjected to a treatment (heat or fumigation).
3. The treated wood packaging shall bear a mark (see example below).
The mark shall at minimum include:
IPPC Symbol as reproduced above;
XX ISO two letter country code (e.g. Germany = DE)
000 unique registration numbers assigned for the company that manufactured or treated the wood packaging;
YY IPPC abbreviation disclosing the type of treatment (e.g. HT for “Heat treatment” or MB for “Methyl Bromide”).

VII. Customs Compliance

In the case of any Customs Fines, Penalties, Claims, these will be under the responsibility of the shipper / owner of the cargo.
