



8th CMAS WORLD CUP 2013

FINSWIMMING "Round 4

April 2013 from 12th to 14th - AIX EN PROVENCE - FRANCE

PARTICULAR REGULATION

- **1 – DENOMINATION:**

French Underwater Federation with the CMAS agreement will organize the 4th round of the 8th CMAS World Cup 2013.

- **2 – ORGANIZATION:**

The competition is ruled by the CMAS Finswimming International Rules, by the CMAS Fin swimming World Cup-Pool Rules for race, and by this Particular Rules that every athlete, with his/her enrolment, affirms to know and to agree to them.

The races are according the rules:

CMAS World Cup program (Pool)

> **Senior (Cat. A) M/F:** 50ap, 50sf, 100sf, 200sf, 400sf, 800sf, 50bf, 100bf, 200bf, 100im, 4x100 relay.

> **Junior (Cat. B + C + D) B/G:** 50ap, 50sf, 100sf, 200sf, 400sf, 800sf, 50bf, 100bf, 200bf, 100im, 4x100 relay

OUT OFF CMAS WORLD CUP'S PROGRAM

Junior (Cat. B + C + D) F/G, Senior (Cat. A) H/D : 400im.

- **3 – PARTICIPANTS:**

- **The club need to send agreement from his national federation.**
- Each club must be associated by a National Federation recognized by C.M.A.S. and each competitor must have the National Federation Licence **and CMAS International Sport Licence.**
- In the CMAS Finswimming World Cup Meeting only clubs can participate.
- Each competitor can participate for only one (1) club during the year.
- Each competitor can take part at the World Cup (no limit time for enrolment).
- Each competitor can take part in a maximum of three (3) individual races and one (1) relay in World Cup.
- Each team can enrol a maximum of two swimmers for each individual race.
- Each team can take part to only one male and one female relay per category in World Cup.
- ***It is possible to take part in races of the immediately upper category, but the swimmer cannot compete on the same distance in two different categories.***



- **4 – COMPETITION:**

- The competition will take place in the
“Yves Blanc” Swimming pool, Aix en Provence
Av. des Ecoles Militaires
13100 AIX en PROVENCE
- The swimming pool has a length of 50 m., a width of eight (8) lanes.
- Electronic Timekeeping “STRAMATEL” by FFESSM.

- **5 – ENTRY DATE:**

- Preliminary entry form: **15th March 2013** (enclosure 1)
- Final entry form: **4th April 2013** (enclosure 2 & 3)
- For the French Clubs, **enrolments are available only by website.**

- **8 – DOPING:**

- Anti-Doping Control follows the rules of CMAS.

- **9 – CLASSIFICATIONS:**

10 – AWARDING CEREMONIES AND PRIZES:

The awarding ceremonies of the World Cup will take place during the competition, so the interest athletes should be at organizing staff disposal at the right time. The organizing committee will take all the prizes assigned to swimmers that aren’t present at their prize giving. During the ceremony the athletes must wear the official uniform of their club.

 - ▲ Medals will be given to the first, second and third classified in every individual race and relays.

▲ 1st, 2nd, 3rd clubs will be given prizes (G/B/W/M/General).

- **11 – ACCOMMODATION:**

- France Sport Association is delegate by the French Federation to organise transfers and accommodation during the days of the competition. You can find all information's and conditions in the document accomodationAix.pdf.

- **12 – COMPETITION FEE:**

- The participant fee to join the competition are the following:

- **POOL : 25€/ team, 15€/ swimmer et 10€/ relay.**

- **LONG DISTANCE : 25€/team, 15€/ swimmer**

- **POOL and LONG DISTANCE : 35€ /team, 20€/ swimmer**

- **13 – VARIOUS :**

- Protest fee follows the rules of CMAS.
- Organizers reserve the right for any change in the program.
- Withdrawal can be announced not later than 5 days before the competition.
- A 50 Euro fee will be paid to the organizer for swimmer who declares withdrawal after this time (art. 7.5 World Cup Rules).
