The City of Chania











Chania is considered to be the most poetic and cultured city of Crete. Visitors are astonished of the romantic taste of beauty

of the scenery that comes from the ruins of ancient Kidonia, over which Chania is located. Castles, walls, antiquities, monastries and

churches compose the leftovers of the intruders during centuries.

The city has two entrances: the airport of Akrotiri and the port of Souda which is the largest of the Mediterranean. Public market holds

a master place in the centre of the city with a an impressive star-shapped building in the center of it, that completed in 1913 in the pattern of the market of Marseille.

Chania is located at the western part of Crete and is divided into 5 provinces, covers 140.000 km2 with population 140.000 residents.

North, south and west sides of Chania are surronded by the sea; peninsulas, Libyan sea and breathtaking beaches are mirroring the sunlight of Europe.

Tourist Information


The area of Chania, due to its natural beauty and variety of sights, attracts many tourist from all over the world. The city also accepts visitors who are interested in economical activities in the area, as well as scientists and educators, who are interested in historical files, historical monuments and museums or are interested to visit the Technical University of Crete, which is an important research centre. The following diagrams show the tourist movement in the area of Chania during the last decade. The elements are from official sources.



Tradition

The Cretan folk tradition which is marked mainly in weaves, jewelry, carpets, blankets, elaborated utensils, pottery, expresses the feel of beauty and artistic mood of the people of Chania. Simple village women, but also organized agricultural associations, make small "miracles" from silk and wool. You will also notice plenty of handicrafts from glass, wood, metal, along with pottery, woodwork and metalwork workshops. Give yourself some time to watch the production of the black leather boots "stivania" at Skridlof street in Chania where the smell of the processed leather is dominant and do not miss the opporunity to read poems that are gravened on Cretan knifes.

PARTICIPATION

Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition. Each national team should respect the rules of championship, the safety conditions set by the organizers and CMAS rules and regulations.

- Swimming-pool events: No more than two (2) athletes per national team are allowed to compete in each individual event and no more than one team per relay event.
- Long Distance events: No more than four (4) athletes per national team are allowed to compete in each individual event and no more than one team per relay event.

Each national team must bring two (2) national flags (m. 2,00 x m. 1,00) and a CD with the national anthem (short version).

DISCIPLINES AND DISTANCES (Male and Female)

Swimming-pool:

Surface Fin swimming (SF): 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1.500m

Apnea (AP): 50m

Immersion (IM): 100m, 400m Relay: 4x100m, 4x200m Bifins (BF): 50m, 100m, 200m.

Open Water:

Individual: 6.000m Relay: 4x2.000m

BOTTLE FILLING

The organizer guarantees the filling of DIN 200 or YOKE cylinders (bottles). The maximum charging pressure is 200 bar. All cylinders (bottles) must be in good condition and must have passed a hydraulic test 24 months prior to the date of the championship.



The championship will be carried out over a period of 4 days and in 8 sessions.

Swimming pool events:

The qualifying heats are scheduled in the morning and finals in the afternoon.

All heats except 50m AP, 50m SF and 100m SF, 50m BF and 100m BF are swum in direct finals (heats with time classification).

All other distances: qualifying heats and finals.

Open Water events: Final race with all participants. The championship program is as follows:



OFFICIAL COMPETITION POOLS AND TRAINING

The swimming pool competition part of 13th World Junior Championship will take place in the "Nautical Club Chania Swimming Complex".

Adress: Akti Kanari, Nea Chora Chanion



This sport complex, with a capacity of 2.000 spectators and includes two swimming pools. The outdoor competition swimming pool is a 50 meters and 8 lanes pool with variable debth, and average temprature 260 + 10 C.

On the other side, the training swimming pool is a 25 meters and 6 lanes pool.

The complex also include: Two groups of dressing rooms. Each group has adequate space for 100 persons with: showers, toilets, massage and rest rooms, dressing rooms for officials, separate from athletes, with showers and lockers etc.

It also includes numerous rooms for preparation, meetings, victory ceremonies, preparations and cafeteria.

- 2010 MEDITERANNEAN SYNCHRONISED SWIMMING CUP



OPEN WATER







The Open Water competition part of 13th World Junior Championship will take place at the historic port of Chania, one of the most touristic places in Greece.

History and spectable combined in the same scenery will compose a maggnificent unprecedented show for finswimming.

At the same time, participants' security during competition will be protected by the certified life-guard team of the Nautical Club of Chania. They have at their disposal all modern means (jet skis, life-guard boats etc.) as well as a medical team always available for immediate assistance.

BOOKING & ENTRY FEE

- Choice 1 (7 days): Entry fee per participant is 750,00 Euros. The organizer will provide:
- Accommodation in four star hotels with double or triple hotel rooms.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, starting with dinner on the **25th June** and ending with breakfast on the **1st July 2014**.
- Transfers from international Chania airport to hotel and return extra fee **20,00 Euros**.
- Free transfers between the official hotel and swimming pool and the Open Water venue.
- Participation at the opening and closing ceremony.
- Choice 2 (6 days): Entry fee per participant is 700.00 Euros. The organizer will provide:
- Accommodation in four star hotels with double or triple hotel rooms.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, starting with dinner on the 25th June and ending with breakfast on the 30st June 2014.
- Transfers from international Chania airport to hotel and return extra fee 20,00 Euros.
- Transfers between the official hotel and swimming pool.
- Participation at the opening ceremony and farewell.
- Choice 3 (4 days): Entry fee per participant is 350,00 Euros. The organizer will provide:
- Accommodation in four star hotels with double or triple hotel rooms.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, starting with dinner on the **28th June** and ending with breakfast on the **1st July 2014**.
- Transfers from international Chania airport to hotel and return extra fee 20,00 Euros.
- Transfers between the official hotel and the Open Water venue.
- Participation at the welcome party and closing ceremony.
- Extra charges for single room ascend to 45. Euros per day.
- Extra day charged at 85. -- Euros per day, including full board and accommodation.
- Any requests or queries on the price of the hire of the pool outside championship dates should be sent directly to the organizing committee.

1. PAYMENT

Minimum 50% of total entry fee should be deposited at our bank no later than **20th April 2014** to guarantee the booking. After this date (20th April 2014) the participation fee will increased by a further 10% of the total amount. The remaining payment should be made on arrival. The organizer will only accept cash or transfers (bank charges will be charged to the remitter).


