



# 11<sup>th</sup> CMAS WORLD CUP 2016

FINSWIMMING "Round 4

April 2016 from 1 to 3 - AIX EN PROVENCE - FRANCE

## PARTICULAR REGULATIONS

### 1 – DENOMINATION:

French Underwater Federation with the CMAS agreement will organize the **4<sup>th</sup> round of the 11<sup>th</sup> CMAS World Cup 2016.**

### 2 – ORGANIZATION:

The competition is ruled by the CMAS Finswimming International Rules, by the CMAS Fin swimming World Cup-Pool Rules for race, and by this Particular Rules that every athlete, with his/her enrolment, affirms to know and to agree to them.

The races are according the rules:

#### **CMAS World Cup program (Pool)**

> **Senior (Cat. A)** M/F: 50ap, 50sf, 100sf, 200sf, 400sf, 800sf, 50bf, 100bf, 200bf, 100im, 4x100 relay.

> **Junior (Cat. B + C + D)** B/G: 50ap(not for cat.D), 50sf, 100sf, 200sf, 400sf, 800sf, 50bf, 100bf, 200bf, 100im, 4x100 relay

**OUT OFF CMAS WORLD CUP'S PROGRAM : SCAFMAN TROPHY 400m immersion.**

**Junior (Cat. B + C + D) F/G, Senior (Cat. A) H/D :**

### 3 – PARTICIPANTS:

In the CMAS Finswimming World Cup Meetings, only National Federations' teams and Clubs can participate.

The club or federal's team needs to send agreement from his national federation on corresponding CMAS form application.

Each club must be affiliate to a national federation recognized by CMAS and each competitor must have CMAS International Sport Licence.

Each competitor can participate for only one (1) club during the year.

Each competitor can take part in a maximum of three (3) individual races and one (1) relay in World Cup.

Each team can enroll a maximum of two swimmers for each individual race.

Each team can take part to only one male and one female relay per category in World Cup.

It is possible to take part in races of the immediately upper category, but the swimmer cannot compete in two different categories except for relay



#### **4 – COMPETITION:**

The competition will take place in the

“Yves Blanc” Swimming pool, Aix en Provence  
Av. des Ecoles Militaires  
13100 AIX en PROVENCE

The swimming pool has a length of 50 m., a constant depth of 2m and with eight (8) lanes.  
Electronic Timekeeping “STRAMATEL” by FFESSM.

#### **7 – CHECK DOCUMENTS AND EQUIPMENTS:**

The judges will check all the participants' documents and equipments  
1 April 2016 at the swimming pool according program

#### **8 - EQUIPMENT:**

The equipment of the swimmer must comply with the rules of CMAS.

Dip bottles should be empty when checking the equipment, date of retesting shall be less than 2 years from the date of the competition, they will be in good condition without any apparent damage or excessive rust. The connection fitting must be of type DIN.

**For any other system, the appropriate adapter must be provided by the competitor.**



### **9– COMPETITION FEE:**

The participant fee to join the competition are the following:

**25 euros per team**

**7 euros each distance**

**15 euros per relay.**

Withdrawal can be announced not later than 5 days before the competition.

A 50 Euro fee will be paid to the organizer for swimmer who declares withdrawal after this time (art. 7.5 World Cup Rules).

### **10– DOPING:**

Anti-Doping Control follows the rules of CMAS.

### **11– CLASSIFICATIONS:**

For every race of the CMAS Finswimming World Cup Meetings, the classification will be according the following CMAS Swimming-Pool Individual Point Table:

All other swimmers who finish the race will receive 1 point for a successful participation.

### **12 – AWARDING CEREMONIES AND PRIZES:**

The awarding ceremonies of the World Cup will take place during the competition, so the interest athletes should be at organizing staff disposal at the right time. The organizing committee will take all the prizes assigned to swimmers that aren't present at their prize giving. During the ceremony the athletes must wear the official uniform of their club.

#### **Individual prizes:**

- Medals will be given to the first, second and third classified in every individual race and relays.

#### **Club prizes:**

- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> clubs will be given prizes (G/B/W/M/General).
