## Finswimming Commission

Mr. President,

You received a first letter January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2017 to inform you on endorsement of FISU for the 4<sup>th</sup> edition University Competition in Finswimming scheduled in OLSZTYN on 24 and 25 April 2017.

In this letter, we explained the new direction in 2017 with the conditions of registration and participation requested by FISU, Universities and Colleges. We gave you explanations also precisely the conditions that we recall below:

<http://sport.cmasoffice.org> . This link must be used by colleges and universities as well as by national federations in order to use only one platform of registrations. You will receive information when the access to database will open.

The conditions of participation for the Colleges and Universities are as following:

- National Federation may register as usually but through integration of the participants into College or University.

Or

- A College or University team. To participate, it's mandatory:
  - That the national federation of the country affiliated to CMAS participate in the CMAS 2014, 2015, 2016 championships,

Or

- That the national federation is adherent to CMAS for Finswimming commission.

Classification: as you are able to check into the specific rules enclosed, the system of countries classification will be the same as the world cup using the same table CMAS 50 points.

Thus, **even the individual registration will be by University and College, it will be a countries ranking** because we know that it's still important for you. And don't forget to give information to your N.U.F. of your participation.

We recall previous levels of participation:

ITALY - LIGNANO SABBIA D'ORO, 2 to 6 August 2014

Total number of athletes 111, Number of Countries 23, Number of Continents 4

POLAND - OLSZTYN, 13 to 14 April 2015

Total number of athletes 75, Number of Countries 13, Number of Continents 3

GREECE - VOLOS, 29 to 30 June 2016

Total number of athletes 134, Number of Countries 25, Number of Continents 4

For this 4<sup>th</sup> edition, we count on your help, your support to equalize the number of countries participating at 23/25. All of us are concerning for the success in 2017 that surely FISU will check it, in frame of its new political direction.
