# **TOMSK REGION**

**Tomsk Region** is located in the geographical center of Siberia and belongs to the Siberian Federal District. The city of Tomsk is the administrative center of Tomsk Region, with the population of the former exceeding 500 thousand people. Founded as a military fortress in 1604, Tomsk became the stronghold of the Russian exploration of Siberia. Nowadays the area of the region is 314.4 thousand km², its total population is 1034.9 thousand people.

Tomsk Region is an industrially developed territory. Its industrial sector is dominated by oil and gas extraction industry, chemical, petrochemical and electric power industries as well as instrument making and metal processing. Dynamic development of oil and gas sector is one of prerequisites of sustainable development of the regional economy. Tomsk

Region is among top oil and gas producing regions in Russia.







Tomsk Region authorities are aspiring to provide the Region's citizens with the best quality of life in Siberia relying on the model of intensive development. Our region has reached a lot in the last three years in the field of economy diversification. Innovation activity has become an integral part of almost all the branches of the regional economy. The annual growth of the innovation output constitutes 10-15%. Key per capita indicators of small and medium size business development make Tomsk Region one of the Russian champions in this area.

Tomsk Region may also boast strong research and educational complex. Tomsk State University, founded in 1878, is the oldest university in the Asian part of Russia. National Research Tomsk State and Tomsk Polytechnic Universities are in the 5-100 Federal Project aiming to promote a group of leading Russian universities in the global research and

educational market.





## THE CITY OF TOMSK

The city of Tomsk is the administrative center of Tomsk region, Russia, located on the Tom River. The city is the oldest in Siberia and is a major educational, scientific and innovation center that includes 9 universities, 15 research institutes, a special economic zone of technical innovation type and 6 business incubators. Tomsk is a member of the Association of Siberian and Far Eastern cities.

The city is rich in monuments of wooden and stone architecture of XVIII-XX centuries.

The city's population is 564,910 people.

#### Sights of Tomsk

The unique monuments of Russian architecture are the main historical value of Tomsk. Among the variety of buildings are world-scale sights. The building of Tomsk State University, a true example of classicism, is among the outstanding attractions. Tomsk is particularly known to have a lot of old buildings made of wood. Tomsk has managed to preserve entire blocks of artistically valuable wooden architecture, parts of streets and houses.



#### Vegetation

The city has a number of green areas (parks, gardens, groves). Most of them are concentrated in the city center: Lagerniy Garden, City Garden, Siberian Botanical Garden, University Grove, Novosobornaya square, Buff-garden, Igumen park, and others.

#### Climate



# SWIMMING POOL

Aquatics Centre Zvezdniy is a unique sports facility in Tomsk. The Zvezdniy is one of the largest sports complexes in Western Siberia. The main object of the sports complex is an Olympic-size swimming pool where the race course is 50 meters in length. Thanks to modern cleaning technology, the sports complex provides crystal-clear water for activities and recreation all year round.

Total area is 14697.7 square meters. There are two swimming pools in the complex: one is 50x25 m and the other is 25x25 m. The depth of the first one is 2.15 m, of the second one is 3.2 m. The pool is equipped with automatic timing system «Omega» and full-color video display. Pools are divided into 10 lanes. There are three sports halls: hall of dry swimming, dance hall, gym. There are also four saunas, massage rooms for recovery of athletes. The center has a conference hall for 60 seats. There are two video-audio control booths in the «Center of swimming» that can create and edit video and audio signal and transmit information through satellite links. During sporting events the complex can accommodate up to 1400 spectators.








# LONG DISTANCE

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The competition will take place in Tomsk (Russia) from 31 July to 07 August 2017. Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition. Each national team should respect the championships rules, the safety conditions set by the organizers and the CMAS rules and regulations.

### PARTICIPATION

#### **SWIMMING-POOL EVENTS:**

Each country may enter no more than two (2) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team.

The entries must reach CMAS headquarters within the time limits set by the CMAS rules on www.cmasoffice.org (§ Point 1.21.1.3 &4 of CMAS Procedures)

World and Continental Championships will be organized over four (4) days and eight (8) sessions.

The qualifying heats are scheduled in the morning and finals in the afternoon except 400 IM, 800 SF and 1500 SF slow heats in the morning and fast heat in the afternoon. For this reason, it's requested to the national federations to send to the CMAS HQ the official protocols of all national selection competitions in delay maximum of two weeks after the competitions (in one of the three CMAS languages). Thus, times of enrollments of the swimmers will be checked for CMAS championships. If the protocols aren't transmitted in this deadline, times of corresponding enrollments will be cancelled and the athletes will be engaged with time 00:00:00.

#### **OPEN WATER EVENTS:**

Each country may enter not more than four (4) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team.

The relay team is mixed. It is necessarily composed of two female athletes and two male athletes. The starting order is free and is decided by the team leader according to the point 8.2.4. of the Finswimming rules

Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition. Each national team should respect the championships rules, the safety conditions set by the organizers and the CMAS rules and regulations. Competition is individual in 1 age category (male/female 14-17 years old (2000-2003 year of birth)). Every National team must bring with it two (2) national flags (m. 2,00 x m. 1,00) and a CD with the national anthem.

#### **DOPING CONTROL**

Organising committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules

#### CYLINDERS FILLING

Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed. For pool competitions, the minimum volume of a compressed air cylinder (bottle) is 0.4L (zero point four liter). The maximum filling pressure for the compressed-air cylinders cannot exceed 200 bar (20 MPa). When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder, is allowed. All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if it is required by the local legislation. Each cylinder must be presented empty during checking meeting before competition. The organizer guarantees the filling of DIN 200, YOKE cylinders (bottles).

\*Bottles equipped DIN could be available to National teams through a written booking request at the time of subscription and in which details about the quantity and wished volumes should be provided.

National teams should bring three (3) national flags (m  $2,00 \times m$ . 1,00) and a CD with the national anthem (short version).

- Participation at the opening ceremony

#### CHOICE 3 - 4 DAYS (3 overnight stay): from 04 to 07 August

Entry fee per participant is **350 €**. The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in three stars hotels with single, double or triple hotel rooms (economy)
- Breakfast, lunch & dinner, starting with dinner on 04 August & ending with breakfast on 07 August
- Transfer from TOMSK airport to the hotels and return
- Providing of 2x0,5l drinking water per person/day
- Free transfers between the official hotels and the venues (swimming pool, Open Water venue)
- Participation at the closing ceremony
- Athletes Party

#### NOT OFFICIAL ORGANIZATION PARTICIPANTS:

Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than the official hotels of the organization must pay a fee of **250 €** per person for secretarial fees, competition, opening and closing ceremony and athletes Party. Local transfers and food providing will not be provided in this case.

#### **EXTRA CHARGES:**

Transfer from NOVOSIBIRSK international airport to the hotels and return - 100 €/person

Single room (standart): extra charges 30 € person/day

Single room (luxe): extra charges 45 € person/day

During the championship dates, the offer includes all benefits. Outside the championship dates, the offer includes full board only.

- Training camp before Championship: teams wishing to organize a training camp before the championships must specify their request to the organizing committee (date, effective, number of water lines) before June 1, 2017. The organization will gives the rate as soon as it is available. The estimated cost of 1 training session: 10 euro per person.
- Immersion Cylinders of 1 to 4 liters could be available to National teams upon reservation: 10 € per bottle.
- Local transportation during the extra days: walking is possible between hotels and pool. In addition, a taxi service may be offered at the delegation charge.

Deadline for the hotel booking: 15th OF MAY 2017.

Late registrations will not guarantee the accommodation booking.

The organizer accepts only cash or bank transfers in Euros (bank charges will be billed to the sender). Bank checks and credit cards will not be accepted. A minimum of 50% of the total entry fee should be deposited at our bank no later than the 1st of june 2017 to guarantee the booking. After this date, the participation fees will increased by a further 15% of total amount. The remaining amount should be paid preferably before 30th july 2017 in case of bank transfer, and before the delegation arrival.
