1 WORLD CUP SPORT DIVING

7 – 10 April, 2017

Klaipeda, Lithuania

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The competition will take place in **KLAIPEDA** (Lithuania) between 7 of April and 10 of April, 2017.

Vilnius – Klaipeda~310km; Kaunas - 220; Palanga - 25km(airport).



2. COMPETITION POOL

The competition will be held in a newly built swimming pool "GINTARAS". The address of the swimming pool is S.Daukanto str. 31, Klaipeda, Lithuania.

The swimming pool is 25 meters long, has 5 lanes, average water temp. is 26°C ± 1°C, depth of the swimming pool is 2.5 meters.

3. THE ORGANIZERS

The competition is organized by CMAS together with the Lithuanian Underwater Sport Federation, Lithuanian Sports Department, International Olympic Committee (TOK), Kaunas Municipality, Kaunas Sport's Department.

3. PARTICIPATION

Only national federation teams affiliated with CMAS are eligible to participate in this competition. Teams must respect the rules of the championship, as well as the safety conditions and regulations set by the organizers and CMAS.

1. Trial M 200 meters
2. Night Diving
3. Emersion 6 Kg
4. 100 immersion

Team events

1. Obstacle course
2. Reley: 4x100
3. Reley torpedo mix 4x50
4. Octopus 50m

ORGANISATION ENGAGEMENT FEES

40 EURO FOR EACH SPORTSMAN

This fee must be paid until the arrival.

Age of the participants

There is one category, male and female.

One category is for Senior. The minimum age for competition is 14 years (the limit of the age is the age of the competitor on January 1 of the year of the championship; athlete will compete in this category until December 31 of the same year).

One team cannot register more than 2 competitors of the same gender (2 men/women).

Each national team must bring 2 national flags (2m x 1m) and a CD with their national anthem (short version). Teams must also wear matching uniforms, representing their country.

EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS AND UNIFORMITY

The equipment and materials to enter the Scuba Diving in Swimming Pool competition are the following:

- Slip-type swimming trunks for men and complete swimming costume for women.
- Scuba diving face masks.
- Snorkel.
- Diving adjustable or non-adjustable fins (if it is required).
- Diving ballast (if it is required).
- Neoprene or isothermal suit (if it is required).
- Neoprene socks (if it is required).
- Stabilizing jackets.
- Regulator. Octopus.
- Water proof manometer.
- Scuba tank with a volume between 10 and 18 litres. DIN and YOKE.

Competitors must possess the following documents and papers:

- Valid passport
- Valid CMAS license
- Valid medical certificate
- Valid health insurance
- OPEN WATER DIVER *

Preliminary starting lists must be submitted before the 16 -03- 2017. The deadline for team registration and starting list submission is 02-04-2017. Later submissions will not be accepted.

5. INTERNATIONAL JURY

6. CLASSIFICATION AND AWARDS

Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual category (men and women). 1st place winners will receive championship cups as well.

9. BOOKING AND ENTRY FEE

Option (4days): Entry fee per participant is **200 €**. This includes:
- Accommodation in a single, double or triple hotel room.

- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, starting with dinner on the 4 of April and ending with lunch on the 10 of April 2017.

Transfers:

- Vilnius airport – hotel - Vilnius airport - **50€** per person;
- Kaunas – hotel – Kaunas - **40€** per person;
- Palanga – hotel – Palanga - **20€** per person;

Hotel - swimmpool-300m.

Extra day - 50€ per person.

Athletes refusing the full board accommodation offered by the organizers must pay **50EUR per person** organizing fee.
