The CMAS UWR Commission aims to explain the ranking protocol in this letter. The ranking protocol was accepted in the meeting of CMAS UWR Commission which was held in November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015. According to the protocol, the last three championships are considered to create the ranking among the participating federations.

The points are given to the participating countries according to following table:

If there are more than 10 participating federation in a championship then the points can be extended based on the numbers of the participating countries.

After ranking the federations based on above mentioned scored protocol, the number of groups are decided by CMAS UW-Rugby Commission. The group assignment can be explained with an example: 9 federations participate a championship. Three groups are created. The federations are ranked based on above mentioned table and then first three federations are randomly assigned to the groups. After that second three federations are assigned to the groups and so forth.
