

CMAS AQUATHLON WORLD CUP 2017

REGULATIONS&RULES

The competition will take place in Klaipeda, Lithuania on 17 - 20 November, 2017. It will be hosted in "Gintaras" Sports Centre swimming pool (*S. Daukanto g. 31, Klaipėda 9223*) 25 metres long, 5 lanes. Depth 0.90 - 2.0 m, water temperature $27 \circ C \pm 1 \circ C$.

- 1. ORGANISING COMMITTEE: The competition is organised by CMAS; Lithuanian finswimming federation; the council of Klaipeda and ,Gintaras' Sports Centre. - 2. Athletes from different countries and regions participate in World Cup competitions.
- 3. Each team must bring one national flag (m 1.00 x 2.00 m) and the national anthem.
