GENERAL INFORMATION

Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition. Each national team should respect the championships rules, the safety conditions set by the organizers and the CMAS rules and regulations competition, category (male/female 14-17 years old - 2001-2004 year of birth).

Every National team must bring with it three (3) national flags (2,00m x 1,00m) and a CD or flash disk with the short version of national anthem.

PARTICIPATION

Swimming Pool Events:

- Each country may enter no more than two (2) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team.
- The entries must reach CMAS headquarters within the time limits set by the CMAS rules on www.cmasoffice.org (Point 1.21.1.3 & 4 of CMAS Procedures)
- World and Continental Championships will be organized over four (4) days and eight (8) sessions.
- The qualifying heats are scheduled in the morning and finals in the afternoon except 400 BF, 400 IM, 800 SF and 1500 SF slow heats in the morning and fast heat in the afternoon. For this reason, it's requested to the national federations to send to the CMAS HQ the official protocols of all national selection competitions in delay maximum of two weeks after the competitions (in one of the three CMAS languages). Thus, times of enrollments of the swimmers will be checked for CMAS championships. If the protocols are not transmitted in this deadline, times of corresponding enrollments will be cancelled and the athletes will be engaged with time 00:00:00.

Open Water Events:

- Each country may enter not more than four (4) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team.
- The relay team is mixed. It is necessarily composed of two female athletes and two male athletes. The starting order is free and is decided by the team leader according to the point 8.2.4. of the CMAS Finswimming Rules.

Swimming Pool (Male and Female):

Surface (SF):	50m – 100m – 200m – 400m – 800m – 1500m
Apnea (AP):	50m
Immersion (IM):	100m – 400m
Bi-Fins (BF):	50m – 100m – 200m – 400m
Relay:	4x50m SF Mixed – 4x100m SF – 4x200m SF – 4x100m BF Mixed

Open Water:

Morning Session:	4x2000m Mixed Relay
Afternoon Session:	6000m Individual (Male and Female)

International Jury:

CMAS Technical Delegate according to CMAS rules.

Classification and Awards:

According to the CMAS rules.

Doping Control:

Organizing committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules.

Cylinders Filling:

- Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed.
- For pool competitions, the minimum volume of a compressed air cylinder (bottle) is 0.4L (zero point four liter).
- The maximum filling pressure for the compressed-air cylinders cannot exceed 200 bar (20 MPa).
- When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder is allowed.
- All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition.
- Each cylinder must be presented empty during checking meeting before competition.
- The organizer guarantees the filling of DIN 200, YOKE cylinders (bottles).

Flags and National Anthem:

National teams should bring three (3) national flags (2.00m x 1.00m) and a CD or flash disk with the short version of national anthem.

THE BOOKING and ENTRY FEE

Choice 1 (Swimming Pool and Open Water)

8 Days / from 28 July to 04 August:

Entry fee for per participant is **650€**. The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in 5 stars hotel with single, double or triple hotel rooms. (Economy)
- Open buffet breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Meals are starting with lunch on 28 July and ending with breakfast on 04 August 2018.
- Transfers from Istanbul Ataturk Airport to the hotel and return.
- 2x0,5L drinking water (still) for per person / per day.
- Transfers between the official hotel and the venues (Swimming pool, Open Water)
- Participation and transfers to the opening and closing ceremony.
- Participation and transfers to the gala dinner for head of the delegations.
- Participation and transfers to the athletes party.

Choice 2 (Swimming Pool only)

7 Days / from 28 July to 03 August:

Entry fee for per participant is **600€**. The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in 5 stars hotel with single, double or triple hotel rooms. (Economy)
- Open buffet breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Meals are starting with lunch on 28 July and ending with breakfast on 03 August 2018.
- Transfers from Istanbul Ataturk Airport to the hotel and return.
- 2x0,5L drinking water (still) for per person / per day.
- Transfers between the official hotel and the venues (Swimming pool, Open Water)
- Participation and transfers to the opening ceremony.
- Participation and transfers to the gala dinner for head of the delegations.

Choice 3 (Open Water only)

4 Days / from 01 August to 04 August:

Entry fee for per participant is **300€**. The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in 5 stars hotel with single, double or triple hotel rooms. (Economy)
- Open buffet breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Meals are starting with lunch on 01 August and ending with breakfast on 04 August 2018.
- Transfers from Istanbul Ataturk Airport to the hotel and return.
- 2x0,5L drinking water (still) for per person / per day.
- Transfers between the official hotel and the venues (Open Water)
- Participation and transfers to the closing ceremony.
- Participation and transfers to the athlete's party.

Extra Charges:

- Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than the official hotels of the organization must pay a fee of **250€** per person for secretarial fees, competition, opening and closing ceremony and athletes party. Local transfers and meals will not be provided in this case.
- Transfer from Istanbul Sabiha Gokcen Airport to the hotel and return – **50€** per person
- Single room charge will be extra **40€** per room / per day.
- Extra days will be charged as follows:
 - Per person / per day (Double or Triple Room): **70€**
 - Per person / per day (Single Room): **110€**

Deadline for the hotel booking: **11 May 2018**

Later reservations will not be accepted.

Training Camp Before the Championship:

The teams who wishing to organize a training camp before the championship must specify their request to the organizing committee. Special accommodation and transportation prices will be given on request.

Payment:

The organizer accepts only bank transfers in Euros (bank charges will be billed to the sender). Bank checks and credit cards will not be accepted. A minimum of 50% of the total entry fee should be transferred at our bank account no later than the **01 June 2017** to guarantee the booking. The rest of the amount (completion of the total entry fee) should be transferred at our bank account no later than **06 July 2018**. After this date, the participation fees will increased by a further 10% of total amount.
