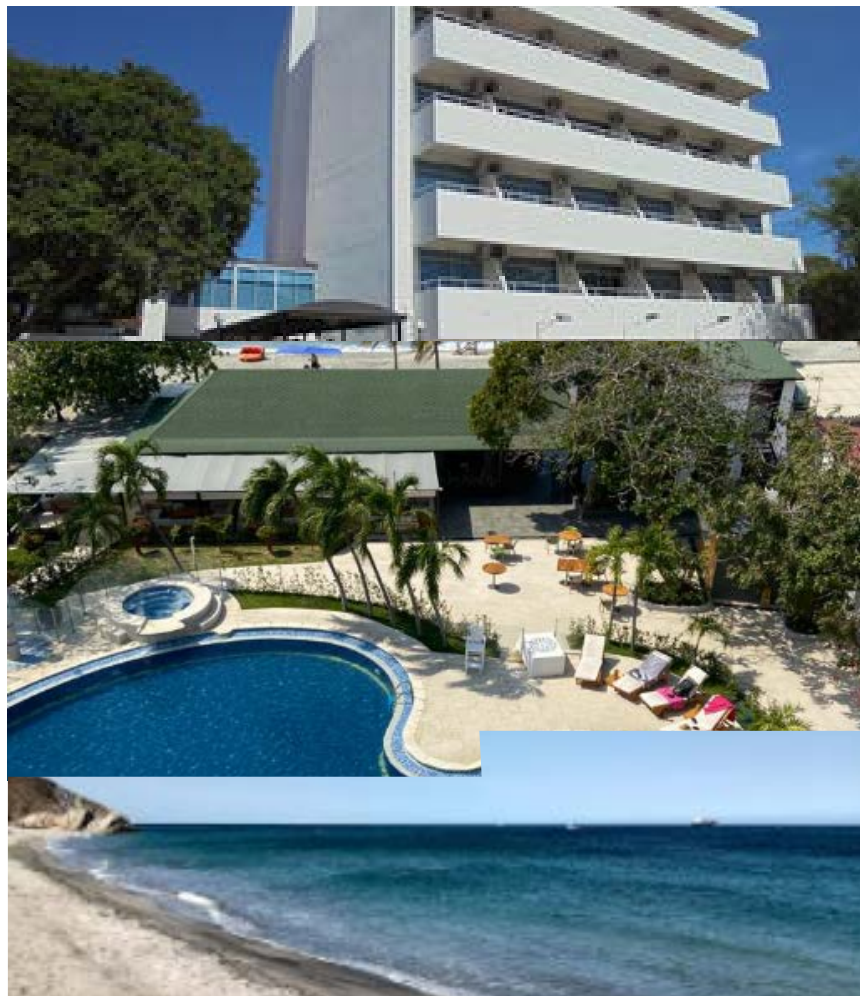

General Information



The competition will take place in Santa Marta, Colombia, from September 23 to 27, 2021, only the teams of the National Federations affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the World Open Water Championship.

Each national team must respect the rules of the field, the safety conditions established by the organizers and the rules and regulations of CMAS.

Place of competition:

The competitions will be developed in the facilities of the Córdova Infantry Battalion, Km4 via Rodadero, San Fernando Vacation Center.





Flags:

National teams must bring three (3) national flags (m. 2.00 x m. 1.00) and a CD with the national anthem (short version).

To Protest:

Doping Control:

Reservation and Entry fee:

Option 1: Five (5) days

From Wednesday 23 to Monday 27 September (Open Water World Championship).

The registration fee per participant is **450,00 €**.

The organizer will provide

- Accommodation in three-star hotels with double rooms in full board.
- Supply of 2x0.5 liters of drinking water per pax / day.
- Participation in the opening ceremony.

In accordance with the biosafety protocol for the management and control of COVID-19 coronavirus. For no reason shall persons outside the bubble scheme be allowed conditions set out in this protocol.

The extra charges per single room amount to **30 €** per pax per day must be done in advance of 20 days to the championship.

Reservation and Entry fee:

Option 2: Six (6) days

From Wednesday 22 to Monday 27 September (Open Water World Championship).

The registration fee per participant is **530,00 €**.

The organizer will provide

- Accommodation in three-star hotels with double rooms in full board.
- Supply of 2x0.5 liters of drinking water per pax / day.
- Participation in the opening ceremony.

In accordance with the biosafety protocol for the management and control of COVID-19 coronavirus. For no reason shall persons outside the bubble scheme be allowed conditions set out in this protocol.

The extra charges per single room amount to **30 €** per pax per day must be done in advance of 20 days to the championship.

Option 3: Seven (7) days

From Monday 21 to Monday 27 September.

The registration fee per participant is **610,00 €**.

The organizer will provide

- Accommodation in three-star hotels with double rooms in full board.
- Supply of 2x0.5 liters of drinking water per pax / day.
- Participation in the opening ceremony.

The extra charges per single room amount to **30 €** per pax per day must be done in advance of 20 days to the championship.

Transportation



Airport Transfer -Hotel- Airport:



Transfer from Santa Marta International Airport to hotel and return, from 1 to 5 people is **60 €** / person.

Transfer from Santa Marta International Airport to the hotel and return, from 6 people onwards **40 €** / person.

Transfer from Barranquilla International Airport to the hotel and return, **80 €** / person, is 104kms away, a tour of 2 hours, approximately.

Transfer from Cartagena International Airport to hotel and return, **130 €** / person, is 227kms, a journey of 4 hours 30 minutes, approximately.

Payments



The organizer accepts only cash or bank transfers in Euros (bank charges will be billed to the sender).

Bank checks and credit cards will not be accepted.

A minimum of 50% of the total entry fee must be deposited with our bank by August 2, 2021 to secure the reservation.

After this date, August 17, 2021, the participation fees will be increased by 10% more than the total amount.

The remaining amount must preferably be paid before September 15, 2021 in case of bank transfer and before the arrival of the delegation.

To Visa



Foreigners who need to enter Colombian territory for any reason, must present a passport valid for at least six months, a visa if your country requires it

In the case of member countries of the Andean Community (Bolivia, Ecuador and Peru) or Mercosur countries (Argentina, Brazil, Uruguay, Paraguay, Venezuela, Chile, Guyana and Suriname), may present the citizenship card or national identity card and complete the Andean immigration card at the time of entry.

Important New requirements for entry to Colombia:

- Submit a Covid-19 PCR test with negative result taken no later than 96 hours before the flight for passengers on international flights without age exceptions (including minors).
- fill out the check-mig [https form](https://apps.migracioncolombia.gov.co/pre-registracion/public/preregistro.jsf) before departure <https://apps.migracioncolombia.gov.co/pre-registracion/public/preregistro.jsf>; if the form is not completed, the air carriers will not allow boarding the flight.
