Technical Notice 2021 - 01

This technical notice concerns the Finswimming rules and particularly:

2.5.1.3. Monofins


From January 1st, 2021: All Monofins need to be certified by CMAS.

The technical requirements to certify Monofins can be found in appendix 1 of the contract signed with Monofins producers. The use of certified fins is mandatory for:

- The participation in CMAS championships, World Cup and international competitions.
- Certification for any records with Monofins

The sticker provided by CMAS to the manufacturers must be affixed on the blade before the sale, thus certifying the Monofin's homologation.

The manufacturers must make sure that the sticker is properly glued to the top of the blade and use a glue that does not allow the sticker to peel off over time or due to the wear of the material ...





Monofin bought on January 1st, 2021:

As a consequence of the new rule all Monofins sold since January 1st should carry the sticker described above. If an athlete buys a Monofin without a sticker, he/she will not be able to use it in CMAS Competitions and Championships.

As a help to the athletes and Federations, we attach the list of official partners of CMAS who are authorised to sell Monofins

Monofin bought before January 1st, 2021:

The Year 2021 will be a transitional year. The Monofins previously bought will be accepted under the following condition:

Each athlete holder of a CMAS licence will receive at least before the CMAS Championships two stickers to paste on the blade of two personal Monofins bought before January 1st, 2021.
