

THE CITY OF FNIDEQ

Fnideq is a town in northern Morocco, on the Mediterranean coast of M'diq-Fnideq Prefecture, situated 31 kilometers north of the city of Tétouan. The town is also known under the Spanish name Castillejos.

It is a seaside town with more than 20 kilometres of beach along the Mediterranean Sea, limited to the south by the Martil River and to the north by the Jdid River.

This territory depends administratively on the prefecture of M'diq-Fnideq and has a total population of almost 90,000 inhabitants.

A significant amount of tourism from different regions of Morocco has developed there since the 1990s, making it a popular tourist destination, mainly for Moroccans, French and Spanish.














CITY MAP OF FNIDEQ & ACCESS

Time of hotel from swimingpool of competition **15 min**;







OFFICIAL COMPETITION & TRAININGS

1. GENERAL INFORMATIONS

The entire event is rule by:

- "CMAS GENERAL RULES COMPETITIONS WORLD CUP CHAMPIONSHIPS Version 2017/01 BOD 195-11/02/2017"
- "CHAMPIONSHIPS ORGANISATION PROCEDURES & OBLIGATIONS, Version 2019/02, BOD 205-26/01/2019 & Updated February 16th"
- PROCEDURES AND OBLIGATIONS FOR THE ORGANISATION OF CMAS COMPETITIONS CATEGORY A World Continental Championships, Version 2019/01, BOD 205 26/01/2019 & Updated February 16th
- "Sport Diving Rules & Specifications of events -2019 release -+ the linked reference to "Sports Diving INTERNATIONAL RULES, (Version 2008/00)"

The competition will take place in Fnideq (Marocco) from June 9th to June 11th 2022. World Cup will be organised over two (2) days and four (4) sessions.

2. PARTICIPATION

Only <u>club's team officially registered from a federation affiliated with CMAS</u> are eligible to compete in the competition.

Each club's team should respect the rules of the cup, the local organisers' (LOC's) safety conditions, and CMAS rules and regulations.

SWIMMING POOL EVENTS:

Each club may register not more than two (2) swimmers for each individual distance, two (2) pair for each pair distance and one (1) relay team (i.e. 4 pax), by category (M-Male, F-Female and/or MX-Mixed).

If the relay team is mixed, it's composed of two female athletes and two male athletes. The starting order is free and is decided by the team leader. The team leader will inform the Chief Judge before competition during registration of the team.







The are only final heats scheduled in the morning and in the afternoon. For this reason, it's requested to the clubs to send to LOC the official protocols of all teams for competitions within the final team list (see below for schedule). The list of national records for athletes registering in competition (start list), should be sent to the organising committee.

If the protocols aren't transmitted in this deadline, times of corresponding enrolments will be cancelled and the athletes will be engaged with time 00:00:00.

The World Cup (Masters) is individual in I age category:

- "Masters": I age group, male & female from 29 years old.

No athlete is admitted to take part in a competition of an age category lower than his/her own age category.

An athlete is allowed to compete in a higher category but will be registered in this category for the entire event, except for the constitution of a relay team (i.e. 4 pax). In that present case, the athlete will compete in this category only for the concerned relay(s).

3. CLASSIFICATIONS & AWARDS

There will be classification for Individuals, Clubs and Nation.

Individual classification:

There will be, for every distance, one individual classification by gender: men, women, mixed. - I age category: masters -.

All swimmers/pair/relay registered by Clubs are in this classification.

Club Classification:

The general club classification will be made by the total amount of points calculated in a special ranking for each distance, considering for it only the best individual, the best pair + the best relay, registered by club for each distance of the competition.(for men, women and, mixed)

A special club classification will be made with this selection - in I age category: masters -.

According to this special ranking, each club will collect points from this ranking's points table:

The points collected in this club classification, will be added up together club by club, for each distance.







In the end, the best club will be awarded.

Nations Classification:

The nations classification will be made by the total amount of points calculated in a special ranking for each distance, considering for it only the best 2 individuals, the best pair + the best relay from a same nation, whatever his club (for men, women and, mixed).

A special nation classification will be made with this selection - in I age category : masters -.

According to this special ranking, each nation will collect points from this ranking's points table:

The points collected in this nations classification will be added up together nation by nation.

4. AWARDS

For every distance of the World Cup:

Gold, silver and bronze medals for each distance, individual men and women, pairs men, women and mixed pairs, relay team – I age category, masters –

No money prizes

It's up to the organizer to give gift prizes.

For the General World Cup Classifications:

Club:

A Cup for the club who win the General World Cup Classification.

Nation:

During Gala dinner the 3 best nations are awarded a cup.







5. CYLINDER FILLING:

Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed. Minimum size of bottle & maximum filling pressure according to CMAS Sport Diving rules. (MINIMUM volume of tanks is 5L for athletes who are 12-13 years old; 7L for athletes who are 14-17 years old; 10L for adult athletes who are 18 years old or more.)

When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder, is allowed.

All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if it is required by the local legislation.

Each cylinder must be presented empty during checking meeting before competition.

LOC guarantees the filling of DIN 200 and YOKE cylinders.

For club's team, cylinders can be provided by LOC (upon request, volume and DIN or YOKE, depending to LOC possibilities —on demand => See below §"**TANKS**"-).

The World Cup will be held for clubs registering in Masters categories. It is scheduled in the same place but not in the same time as the preceding World Championships.

This World cup is the last part of an International Diving Festival organised by the FRMPAS (Royal Federation of diving Marocco).

ACCOMMODATION'

Two choice are proposed to athletes, staff and officials: Marina Beach Hotel and Marina Smir Hotel. Both solution are eligible to reservation depending on teams will. Prices depend on teams choice and duration of stay. Prices are described below, indicated by pax and by night.

- If needed and for World Juniors & Seniors Championships, National teams, staff and official's reservation should be at least from June 5^{th} to June 10^{th} 2022 (6 days, 5 nights) -

For World Cup Masters, Club's teams, staff and officials reservation should be <u>at least</u>: => From June 8th to June 12th 2022 (5 days, 4 nights);

IMPORTANT:

Full board accommodation is considered as breakfast, warm lunch, warm dinner and water drink 0,5l per meal included.

During the competition, training and training camp, the offer includes all benefits.

Out of that the offer includes full board only.

BOOKING & ENTRY FEES

Despite the hotel choice, LOC will provide:

- Free transfers between the official hotel and swimming pool (on training day and training camp).
- Participation at the competition + closing ceremony and party / Gala dinner.

C) TRAINING CAMP:

Teams wishing to organise a training camp before the competition must specify their request to the organising committee (date, number of athletes and staff -One line by federation-) before May 1, 2022.

The cost of training sessions is free of charge (extra nights for duration of stay in extra). For organisation purpose, clubs should request and give all details of their will to LOC in the scheduled time.

Furthermore, teams should book for the number of nights needed regarding the duration of training camp.







D) TANKS

- Immersion Cylinders of 10 to 12 litters could be available to clubs upon reservation: **renting is free of charge, but clubs who wants to reserve cylinder should contact LOC before, for organisation questions.**
- There are NO immersion Cylinders of 5L (12-13 y.o) and 7L (14-17 y.o) to lend from LOC for the athletes. They should provide and travel with their own gears.

E) EXTRA CHARGES

- => Transfers from TANGER international airport to hotel and return: +60,00 €/pax
- => Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than official can participate to the competition: it includes secretarial fees, competition, opening and closing ceremony. No local transfers will be provided.

PAYMENTS

LOC accepts only cash or bank transfers in Euros ONLY (bank charges will be billed to the sender). Bank checks and credit cards will not be accepted.

A minimum of 50% of the total entry fee should be deposite at our bank no later than the May 18rd 2022 to guarantee the booking.

After this date, the participation fees may be increased by a further 10% of total amount.

The remaining amount should be paid preferably before May 30th 2022 in case of bank transfer, and before the delegation arrival.

Registration

All registration of athletes for events must be submitted <u>only through an electronic way</u>. Application forms can be used only for accommodation, general organisation and other items proposed.

Registration short Tutorial:

For registration, you need an account.

- a) Users who already have registered an account in the system, please re-use your account. In this case, you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees and officials data.
- b) If you don't have an account yet, please register online:

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials, please follow these steps:

- Log in with your account.
- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- If the calendar goes to the event you want to register for, click on the "Registration" button of the event you want to register.
- On the bottom of the entries site, you see the functions to make new entries.
- Register your competitors/teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials.
- All your registrations go first on a waiting list to be validated. After the payment process is finished, your registrations are approved, and you are notified by email.
- You can find an overview of all your registrations at "My current entries". There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the "Other Items" section of the event. The organiser may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

a. CMAS Fees

To participate, each competitor must pay CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.







40,00 Euro by pax for participation fees



Please note that the names of relays members must be entered during the registration process based on individual registration even if they swim only in a relay and even if, according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on-site before the beginning of the competition.

These fees are paid only at the end of the registration process online by credit card.

The entries must reach LOC within the time limits set below. Each member of the team should have a valid CMAS licence provided by his federation before team registering.
