1. Denomination

The Association of Thailand Underwater Sport (ATUS); section Sport Diving - authorized by CMAS- invites all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the Final Sport Diving World Cup from 5th -7th September 2022 in Phuket, Thailand.

2. Legal COVID-19 regulations & hygiene concept

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the applicable legal provision in Phuket, Thailand, most likely the organizer must provide special hygiene guidelines. Probably a corresponding hygiene concept and other relevant information will be part of these specific rules. These will be binding for all participating clubs and individuals and must be observed.

Thailand's Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) approved the lifting of the RT-PCR testing requirement for international arrivals beginning 1 May 2022 and introduced two new entry schemes specifically customized for vaccinated and unvaccinated travelers.

New entry rules for vaccinated travelers:

International travelers who are fully vaccinated will no longer be required to show proof of a pre-arrival negative RT-PCR test nor undergo an arrival test.

They are still required to register for a Thailand Pass (via <https://tp.consular.go.th/>) with a Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination and an insurance policy with coverage no less than US\$10,000 (reduced from US\$20,000).

Once arriving in Thailand, they will be allowed entry and are free to go anywhere in the kingdom.

New entry rules for unvaccinated travelers:

International travelers who are unvaccinated or are not fully vaccinated will also no longer be required to show proof of a pre-arrival negative RT-PCR test nor undergo an arrival test.

They are required to register for a Thailand Pass with a 5-day hotel booking and an insurance policy with coverage no less than US\$10,000 (reduced from US\$20,000).

Once arriving in Thailand, they must proceed to undergo quarantine for 5 days and undergo an RT-PCR test on Day 5.

The exception is made for unvaccinated travelers who can upload proof of a negative RT-PCR test within 72 hours of travel via the Thailand Pass system, they – like those fully vaccinated – will be allowed entry and are free to go anywhere in the kingdom.

While in Thailand, both vaccinated and unvaccinated travelers are advised to strictly follow health and safety standards. Travelers who are experiencing COVID-like symptoms should get tested. If testing positive, they must get the appropriate medical treatment.

3.Registration process

The competition is governed by CMAS Sport Diving Rules, and by the present Specific Rules that every athlete-with his/her enrolment-affirms to know and agrees to strictly follow.

1. **Registration**

All registration of athletes for events must be submitted only through electronic ways. Application forms can be used only for accommodation.

Each competitor can take part in a maximum of four (4) different individual races, two (2) different pair races^(*) and two (2) different relay races.

() For team races in which separate gender + mixed gender is available, each competitor can participate for those races in his/her category + twice more for the mixed category (pair or relay), leading to the potential participation to six (6) team races : 2 different pair races in his/her category + 2 different relay races in his/her category + 2 different pair or relay mixed races.*

2. **Registration tutorial:**

For registration, you need an account.
Users who already have registered an account in our system, please re-use your account. In this case, you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees, and official data.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees, and officials please follow these steps:

- Log in with your account.
- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees, and officials.
- In the event calendar go to the event you want to register for and click on the "Registration" button for the event you want to register.
- On the bottom of the entries sit you will see the functions to make a new entry.
- Register your competitors/teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees, and officials.



- All your registrations will go first on a waiting list to validate them. After the payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved and you will be notified by E-Mail
- You can find an overview of all your registrations at "My current entries". There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the "Other Items" section of the event. The organizer may also provide additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

3. Fees for registration

a) CMAS Fees

To be allowed to participate to this competition, each athlete must pay the participating **CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS Board : 20€** for participation fees for all the competition (Senior/Junior, regardless of the number of races by competitor – team will be charged Athlete by Athlete, at the end of the Sport DATA process)

Please note that the names of relays members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they swim only relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on the place until the technical meeting that is held before the beginning of the competition is done.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card to be in the starting lists. If no payment, the athletes stay in waiting list and are not integrated into the startlists.

b) Organization Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (inscription fees) are paid directly to the organizing committee (LOC) according to the instructions communicated below ; For each round (= Golden Final, there is no preliminar round of selection), and for each competitor/club/team .. :

Inscription fees to the LOC are:

- 20€ for each club/federal team;
- 14€ per each pair or relay;
- 7€ per distance;
- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.
- Late enrolments are not accepted because registration is managed by the CMAS system during registration planning.
- **Payment for inscription fees should be made by direct bank transfer to the LOC until 24th August 2022. After the closing of registration (20th August 2022) teams will receive all information for bank transfer of inscription fees.**
- Proof of payment must be carried out on the day of the competition.
- Inscription fee receipts will be issued to every club/team upon registration in the swimming pool.
- Cash payment of the inscription fee before the start of the competition is only possible in exceptional cases. If no proof of payment of the inscription fee is possible when registering before the start of the competition, admission to the competition will only be granted after an immediate cash payment of the inscription fee to the organizer.

5. Competition place

The swimming pool facts:

- Length of 50 meters.
- Width of 25 meters
- 10 lanes
- Wave-breaking Lane ropes
- Permanent depth of 2 meters
- Water temperature 25°C (±1°C)



6. Timekeeping system

The timekeeper will conduct time recording through an electronic time and recording system.

The used system is the brand ALGE Timing.

7. Checking equipment and bottle refills

The general control of the equipment (fins, snorkels) and bottles will take place at the swimming pool on Monday, 5th September 2022 from 16.00 to 20.00 o'clock.

In addition, the judges are authorized to control swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.

All bottles used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if the local legislation requires it.

The organizer offered to refill of bottles in the swimming pool. The location of refilling is signposted.



8. Classifications

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers. Results will be complied with according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

There will be a classification for Individuals, Clubs, Federal Teams, and Countries.

For every "point" ranking below, the number of points will be considered as :

- **Individuals:** There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for men, women, boys and girls^(*). Every competitor registered by Clubs or Federal Teams are in this classification.
- **Clubs:** The general classification of clubs will be calculated by the addition of points collected for each distance and category^(*) in a special ranking established with only the best individual, the best pair or the best relay of each club. According to this special ranking, each club will collect points from the ranking's points table.

The points collected this way will be added up together club by club, for each distance and category^(*).

Different separate Club Classification will be made :

- Best club by category^(*)
- Best of all clubs (cumul of the points in all the competition).

- **Federal Teams:** The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (only the men, women, boys and girls^(*) registered by national federations). Four separate Federal Teams Classification will be made : for men, women, boys and girls^(*).
- **Country Ranking:** The general classification of country will be calculated by the addition of points collected for each distance and category^(*) in a special ranking established with only the 2 best individuals, the best pair or the best relay from the same nation, whatever his club or team. According to this special ranking, each country will collect points from the ranking's points table.

The points collected this way will be added up together nation by nation, for each distance and category^(*).



Different separate Country Classification will be made :

- Best Country by category^(*)
- Best of all country (cumul of the points in all the competition).

^(*)men, women, boys and girls + mixed if available // 4 or 5 rankings , depending on whether mixed distance is available or not.

9. Prizes

- **Individual Prizes:** Medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race, every team event and relays.
- **Team Prizes:** Cups will be given to the first three clubs ("Best of all clubs") and the first three Federal Teams.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition; therefore, the involved athletes must be at the organizing staff's disposal at the right time.

During ceremonies, awarded athletes must wear the official uniform of their team.

10. Antidoping

- WADA - World Antidoping Code
- CMAS – Antidoping Rules
- Clubs/teams and athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

11. Responsibility

The National Federation, the Organizing Committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers, and the Chief Judge aren't responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during, or after the competition.

12. Additional Notes

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organizer's judgment or due to COVID-19-related restrictions. Participating teams will receive all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their complete equipment at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

The organizer reserves the right to accept and insert an athlete or relay in the official starting list at least 24h before the opening ceremony, on the specific request of a participating club, and under reserve of a correct sportdata prior registration.

13. VISA

A Thailand visa is required for most foreign nationalities to travel and stay in Thailand for purpose of tourism, business, investment, study, medical treatment, mass media, religion, employment, visiting family, and other activities. The foreigner is required to apply for the appropriate visa from a Thai embassy or consulate.

57 countries have bilateral treaties with Thailand and their nationalities are granted visa exemption. Under the Visa Exemption Program and Bilateral Agreements, 5 countries are granted a 90-day permit to stay, 50 countries are granted 30 days, and 2 countries are granted 14 days' stay in Thailand.

15. Accommodation

1. Booking of accommodation must be made until 1st August 2022.

2. Late bookings are not accepted because room capacities are available only to 1st August 2022
3. Capacities are limited! - Rooms are assigned like "first come, first serve".
4. Package - 2 nights/days **including transfers from the hotel to the competition area** with a **FULL BOARD** from Monday, 5th September 2022, starting with dinner to Wednesday, 7th September 2022, ending with lunch.
5. Package - 2 nights/days **including transfers from the hotel to the competition area** with a **HALF BOARD** from Monday, 5th September 2022 to Wednesday, 7th September 2022, including BREAKFAST ONLY.

 - 6.3 B2 Phuket Premier Hotel is 30\$ per person per day including free Wi-Fi and VAT, NO BREAKFAST.
