Kuwait is located in the northwestern corner of the Arabian Peninsula perched on the tip of the Gulf. Although most part of the country is desert, a long coastline of approximately 499 km extends in the eastern side of the land and has built the bond between Kuwaitis and the sea. The current population of Kuwait is 4,414,256.

The bond between Kuwaitis and diving is genuine. Their history extends back to the 17th century when their lives were dependent on diving in the pearl banks until the development of Kuwait as a trading capital in 1935. This relationship is intertwined and connected with generations of Kuwaitis carrying on the legacy left by the forefathers.

After the discovery of oil in the 1930s and the rapid expansion of the petroleum industry, Kuwait City underwent a huge transformation. Amidst the sprawling malls and grand souks, a stroll can be made for more enjoyable experience.

The Kuwait Towers are three iconic spire-shaped structures located right on the cape of Kuwait bay in the heart of the capital. They were opened in February 26th 1977 and were recently included on the UNESCO World Heritage list as a symbol of technological and engineering achievement and a symbol of national identity.

The scent of exotic spices and traditional commodities can be found at Souk Al-Mubarakiya, the oldest market in Kuwait. Right at the heart of the capital a conventional open-air market specialized in antiques and vintage pieces and provides tourists with a taste of Arabia not only in merchandise but also in traditional food and beverages. Whilst walking in the souk you can hear the Call of Prayer from the Grand Mosque.

The native and official language is Arabic , however, English is the second widely spoken language in the country and can be used to communicate with people, shops, restaurants and professions at all times.

Kuwait 2023 CMAS World Freediving Indoor Championship

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

CMAS has entrusted to the Kuwait Diving & Lifesaving Club (KDLC) the organization of World Freediving Indoor Championship 2023 to be staged with the supervision of CMAS in Kuwait, in the (ALNASR Sporting Club – Swimming Pool Complex), from 7th to 13th May 2023.

The Championship shall be comprised of seven specialties: Dynamic (DYN), Dynamic with Bi-Fins (DYNBF), Dynamic without Fins (DNF), Static (STA), Speed 2x50m, Speed 4x50m and Speed 8x50m. Only the final stage will take place for each of the planned specialties.

These articles supplement and complete the international Rules drawn up for the single specialties.

2. PARTICIPATION

The competition is open to athletes aged 15 and belonging to National Teams fully complying with the provisions of CMAS Regulations, these Special Rules and the Safety Requirements established by the Organizers.

Athletes from 15 to 17 years old participate in junior category. The senior category correspondents to age 18 to 49. Athletes who are at least 50 years old belong to the master's group.

Every National Team should bring (3) national flags $(2m \times 1m)$ and a flash disk with the short version of their national anthem.

Every National team can participate with maximum of 6 men and 6 women in each discipline

3. CLASSIFICATION & PRIZE-GIVING

The Classification and Prize-giving ceremonies should be performed in agreement CMAS Procedures.

The Prize-giving ceremony will be held in the "AlNasr Sporting Club" Swimming Pool Complex at the conclusion of each day competition session.

4. PAYMENT

Single Room + Registration Fee €1,000 per participant for the period of 7 to 13 May 2023.

<u>Double Room + Registration Fee</u> €800 per participant for the period of 7 to 13 May 2023.

Registration Fees Only €400 per participate (not included, accomedation)

Additional days will cost €150 /day.



Kuwait travel adaptors

For Kuwait the associated plug type is G, which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Kuwait operates on a 240V supply voltage and 50Hz.



Restrictions

A. Drugs

It is not permissible by law to acquire, possess, use, trade, buy, sell or transport narcotic products of any kind. In case of failure or refusal to follow the rules, criminal and/or civilpenalties may be imposed.

B. Alcohol

It is prohibited by law to import, export, buy, sell, or carry alcohol in Kuwait. Public intoxication or being visibly drunk is considered an offense.
