1. Denomination

The COLOMBIAN UNDERWATER FEDERATION FEDECAS and VALLE REGIONAL UNDERWATER LIGUE - LIVAS – authorized by CMAS – invite all interested Federations and Clubs to participate on the XVII CMAS Finswimming World Cup 2023 organized FROM MARCH 3rd – 5th 2023 in CALI COLOMBIA.

2. Registration process

The competition is governed by CMAS Finswimming Rules, by CMAS Finswimming World Cup Rules and by the present Specific Rules that every athlete - with his/her enrolment - affirms to know and agrees to strictly follow.

1. Registration



All registration of athletes for events must be submitted **only through electronic way.** Application forms can be used only for accommodation.

Each competitor can take part in a maximum of four (4) individual races and two (2) relays.

Opening date of registration is Thursday 2nd February to Sunday 28th February 2023.

2. Registration Tutorial:

For registration you need an account.

Users who already have registered an account in CMAS system, please re-use your account. In this case you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees and official's data.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees, and officials please follow these steps:

- Log in with your account
- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees, and officials.
- In the event calendar go to the event you want to register for, click on the “Registration” button of the event you want to register.
- On the bottom of the entries site, you will see the functions to make new entries
- Register your competitors / teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees, and officials.
- All your registrations will go first on a waiting list in order to validate them. After the payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved, and you will be notified by email.
- You can find an overview about all your registrations at “My current entries”. There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the “Other Items” section of the event. The organizer may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

Please, read the attached notice with the new instructions for 2023.

In 2023, you need to enter all categories of people who will attend the competition and not only the competitors.

From now on, we will use the system to print the accreditation to access the swimming pool. For this reason, in additionally to the competitors, you need to enter all members of your club:

- Competitors
- Coaches
- Referees
- Officials (all categories).

Note: the registration out of the competitors is free of charge. No CMAS fees will be charged for the categories of Coaches, Referees and all Officials. To finish, all files recorded in the system must upload an ID photo, whatever the category.

After the deadline, the accreditations will be printed and sent to the organising committee, and you will receive them upon arrival.

3. Fees of registration

a. CMAS Fees

For each round or Golden Final, each competitor must participate and pay CMAS fees, fixed annually by CMAS.



- 22,00 € for participation fees by each round.

Please note that relays members' names must be entered during the registration process based on individual registration, even if they swim only relay. According to the rules, the relays' composition can be changed on-site before the beginning of the competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online by credit card.

b. Miscellaneous



- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.

- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after deadline according to registration planning.

c. Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to organising committee according to the instructions communicated below:

Inscription fees are:

- 22 € for each club.
 - 15.5 € per each relay.
 - 8 € per each individual distance.
- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.
 - Late enrolments are not accepted because registration is managed by CMAS system during registration planning.
 - Payment should be made by direct bank transfer to the Bank. Bank informations are confidential. Thus, it will be sent to you on request by email:: worldcupmascal@gmail.com
 - Payments in cash are allowed the 2nd and 3rd March 2023 in the Main office of LIVAS located directly at the swimming pool.

3. LIVAS CUP

We invite all athletes to the LIVAS cup. We will have 2 distances: 400 m IM and 1500 m SF. Inscription fees are 8 € per each individual distance.

- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.
- Payment should be made by direct bank transfer or delivered in cash the 2nd and 3rd March 2023 in the Main office of LIVAS located directly at the swimming pool.

4. Competition place

The competition will take place at:

Swimming Pool Alberto Galindo located in the Street 5B # 34-51, San Fernando, Cali, Colombia

Next to the football stadium Pascual Guerrero.

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, a width of 21 m and eight lanes and a depth of 2m The temperature of the water is 26°C (+ - 1°C).

5. Timekeeping system

Timekeepers with Electronic System.

Checking equipment and bottle refills

The judges are authorized to control swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.

All sports documents of the swimmers will be checked exclusively from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Friday March 3rd 2023.

All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if the local legislation requires it.

6. Classifications

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers; results will be complied according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

- 3.1. There will be classification for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries.
- 3.2. Individual: There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for men, women, Juniors Boys, and girls. Swimmers registered by Clubs or Nationals 'Teams are in this classification.
- 3.3. Club: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual point (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for senior men, senior women, junior boys, and junior girls.
- 3.4. National Teams: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual point (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, junior boys, junior girls.
- 3.5. Countries Ranking:
 - 3.5.1. The Countries Ranking will be made in accordance with points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
 - 3.5.2. If National Federation does not enrol its national team, the best two results by club in accordance with points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance, at each category (men, woman, juniors, and seniors) will go to Countries ranking.

7. Prizes

Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

Teams' prizes: cups for first three clubs and cups for first three National Teams.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes must be at organizing staff's disposal at the right time.

During ceremonies awarded athletes must wear official uniforms of their teams.

8. Antidoping

- WADA – World Antidoping Code
- CMAS – Antidoping Rules
- Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

Responsibility

The Organizing federation, the organizing committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge aren't responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.

9. Additional Note

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organizer's judgment. Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their equipment complete at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

10. Visa

If you need Visa to enter Colombia, please contact the Colombian Federation (FEDECAS) via E-Mail fedecas.colombia@gmail.com not later than 30 days before the competition begins.

11. Enrolment

1. **Preliminary entry** - application form is provided as attachment with these specific rules and must be filled duly (**Enclosure 1 Preliminary Entry Form**)

12. Accommodation and transportation

ACCOMMODATION

Organizers offer accommodation options within the deadline of competition enrolment 15th February 2023.

Full board accommodation is offered in the following categories:

- 2 nights, from Friday 3rd March dinner until Sunday 5th March ending with lunch and including all meals:
Hotel price: 130 €/person (rooms with 2-3 beds)
- 3 nights, from Friday 3rd March dinner until Monday 6th March ending with breakfast and including all meals
Hotel: 195 €/person (rooms with 2-3 beds).



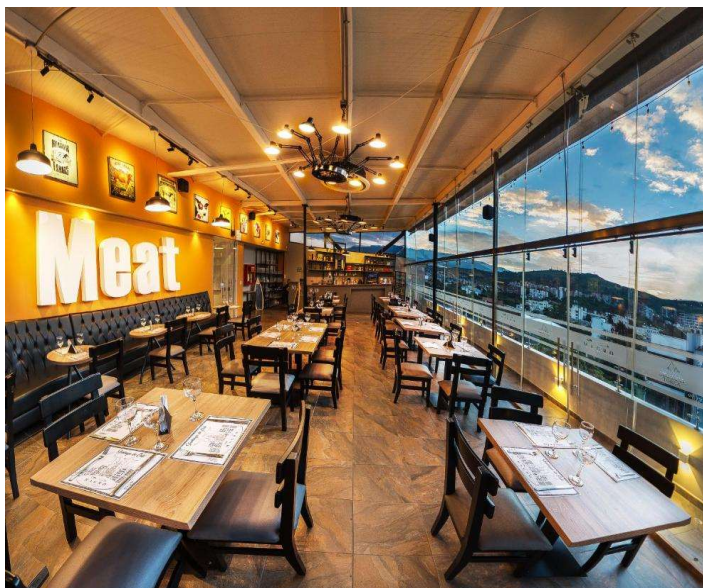

TORCA HOTEL CALI

Located a few minutes' drive from Saint's Peter Cathedral, Torca Hotels Cali offers 47 air-conditioned rooms. Pan-American Park is 250 metres from the venue, while the environmental Cali Zoo is 3 km away. Cali centre can be reached within 30 minutes' walk. Attractions within walking distance include Banderas Park and Tin Tin Deo Taberna.

The units have multi-channel television, ironing facilities and free Wi-Fi plus a private bathroom. Hypoallergenic pillows and linens welcome you to a good night's rest, other nice touches include complimentary toiletries, a hairdryer and dryers.

Torca Hotels features an English breakfast. Guests can enjoy American and Mexican meals at Pasala Pascual within 5 minutes' walk of the hotel. There is Parada MIO - Carrera 36 entre Calle 4D y 5 bus stop close to Torca Hotels, it's about 5 minutes' walk away. Alfonso Bonilla Aragon International airport is 25 km from the accommodation. A night club, entertainment activities and a cable flat-screen are available on the premises.

TRAINING

For any participating clubs wish to arrive earlier to have training session a full board services are offered, paying the pro-rata charge as indicated. Swimming pool lanes are charged separately and will be organise and available according to the local schedule.

Price per hour: 5 €/person

TRANSPORTATION

If transfer is required from ALFONSO BONILLA ARAGON Airport (Palmira) to Cali and return transport can be arranged by the organizers at a cost of 50 Euro/person if groups of more than 5 people travel together. For teams of 1-4 persons the transportation fee will be 60 Euro/person. **(Enclosure 2 Booking Form)**
