2. SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Registration of each National Olympic Committee (NOC) must comply with the regulations of National Committee of Cambodia (NOCC).

2.1 Entry by Number: Deadline for submission of Entry by Number Forms is 30 January 2023 at 24:00 hours Cambodia time (GMT+7).

2.2 Entry by Name: Deadline for submission of Entry by Name Forms is 05 March 2023 at 24:00 hours Cambodia time (GMT+7).

The completed Entry by Name must be submitted for each athlete and include all necessary information. Original form must be presented during the Delegation Registration Meeting (DRM).

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1 To be eligible for participation in the 32nd SEA Games, a competitor must comply with Laws of CMAS, SEA Games Federation (SEAGF) Charter and Rules as well as Rule 40.

3.2 Only nationals of the country of the National Olympic Committee (NOC) shall be qualified to represent the NOC in the Games. All disputes relating to the determination of the country, which an athlete may represent in the SEA Games shall be resolved in accordance with the South East Asian Games Federation (SEAGF) Charter and Rules.

4. DOPING CONTROL

4.1 CAMSOC under the guidance of the SEAGF, will be responsible for the Anti- Doping Programme during the 32nd SEA Games. The Anti-Doping Programme will be implemented in accordance with SEAGF Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code and its relevant International Standards.

4.2 CAMSOC and SEAGF are responsible for providing necessary conditions for Doping testing activities at the 32nd SEA Games. Doping Control procedures will be implemented according to WADA's International Standards for Testing and Investigations. Sample analysis will be performed at a WADA-accredited laboratory.

4.3 Doping Control stations will be set up at the competition venue by CAMSOC, where in-competition testing will be conducted. The Test Distribution Plan and criteria for athlete selection for each sport will comply with the Doping Control protocol established by the SEAGF and WADA.

4.4 During the Games, all athletes are subjected to for the Anti-Doping Programme that is organized by CAMSOC and SEAGF. Testing or sampling can be done at any time and place without any notice.

4.5 The WADA 2022 List of Prohibited Substances and Methods is applied in accordance with the WADA Code .

5. APPROVAL OF THE TECHNICAL HANDBOOK

This Technical Handbook was approved by the Asia Underwater Federation (AUF).

Any further amendments to the Technical Handbook shall be circulated via e-mail to the NOCs.

6. COVID-19 HEALTH PROTOCOL

During the Games, the Swimming Competitions shall adopt the COVID-19 Epidemic control protocols approved by CAMSOC.

7. COMPETITON INFORMATION

7.2 Competition Venue

Morodok Techo National Aquatics Center

7.3 Training

Two (02) days before the competition day at the Competition Venue.

8. EVENTS

The Fin Swimming competition will consist of thirteen (13) categories including eleven (11) men's events, eleven (11) women's events and two (02) mixed event.

9. QUOTAS

9.1 For Individual events, each NOC may enter a maximum of two (02) athletes without reserves.

9.2 For Team events, each NOC may enter a maximum of one (01) team consisting of a maximum of four (04) athletes plus one (01) substitute per relay event. The composition of the relay team may be changed between the Heats and the Finals of the same event.

9.3 For all NOCs that are registered, they can participate in twentyfour (24) of the twenty-four (24) categories, but for those who notify fourteen (14) days before the competition starts, each NOC, with the exception of the host country, can only participate in a maximum of twenty (20) of the twentyfour (24) event categories.

12. COMPETITION PROCEDURES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS

12.1 Competition Procedures

The Fin Swimming competition of the 32nd SEA Games will be held in accordance with the current World Underwater Federation (CMAS) Rules and Regulations under the guidance of the Technical Delegate (TD) appointed by Asian Underwater Federation (AUF).

In case of any disagreement in the language interpretation of the CMAS Rules and Regulations, the English version shall prevail. Any unforeseen cases not covered by the Rules and Regulations shall be resolved as follows:

12.1.1 General Issues: To be resolved in accordance with the SEAGF Charter and Rules.

12.1.2 Technical Issues: To be resolved in accordance with the CMAS Rules and Regulations and CMAS Norms.

12.2 Competition Rules

12.2.1 There will be Heats and Finals in all events, with the exception of the Women's and Men's 800m Surface, in which there will only be a single-timed Final. The times submitted for the fastest competitors will swim in the Final session while the others will

swim in the Heats session. Individual competitors and relay teams will be seeded for the Heats in accordance with the times submitted on the official Entry Forms.

12.2.2 Entries without a submitted time will be seeded by Meet Software.

12.2.3 Competitors will advance to the Finals on the basis of their rankings in the Heats. If there is an equal time for 8th (to 1/100 second), a swim-off will take place after the conclusion of all Heats in the event concerned.

12.3 Official Seeding Lane

The official seeding lane for Swimming will take place in accordance with the CMAS Rules and Regulations at the Team Managers' Meeting.

12.4 Tie Medal Positions in Finals

For Fin Swimming, if the results in the Finals end in a tie in any of the top three (3) positions, the medals will be awarded in accordance with CMAS Rules as follows:

- For 1st position: two (02) Golds, no Silver, one (01) Bronze;

- For 2nd position: one (01) Gold, two (02) Silvers, no Bronze;

- For 3rd position: one (01) Gold, one (01) Silver, two (02) Bronzes

12.5 Video Refereeing (if applicable)

Video refereeing may be used during the Fin Swimming competition from the Heats until the Finals for the Individual events and in the Team Events.

12.6 Disqualification Rules

The reasons for disqualification from Fin Swimming events are violation of CMAS Rules.

12.7 Delays, postponements or cancellations

The Technical Delegate must consult the CAMSOC Secretariat if there is any delay, postponement or cancellation of any competition.

13. SPORT EQUIPMENT AND COMPETITION ATTIRE

13.1 Sports Equipment

All sports equipment used by athletes in competition must comply with the SEAGF Charter and Rules and CMAS Rules and Regulations.

13.2 Clothing

All clothing worn by athletes in competition must comply with the SEAGF Charter and Rules, CMAS, and AUF Rules and Regulations on Swimwear.

14. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS, IT AND JURY OF APPEAL

The appointments of Technical Officials and Jury of Appeal members will be in accordance with the Article 41 in SEAGF Charter and Rules.

14.1 International Technical Officials (ITOs) CAMSOC shall appoint two (02) ITOs for the competition in consultation with AUF.

14.2 National Technical Officials (NTOs) Khmer Swimming Federation (KSF) will appoint such number of National Technical Officials (NTOs) to assist the International Technical Officials.

14.3 Jury of Appeal

The Jury of Appeal shall comprise of one (01) representative from each participating NOC. The Technical Delegate will act as its chairman. The decision of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

15.1 Any written protest, written on the CMAS Form, must first be made and submitted by the Chef de Mission or Team Manager to the Technical Delegate within thirty (30) minutes after the end of the event in which the protest is generated with the payment of a Protest Fee of USD200.00 per protest, payable to CAMSOC. If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the start of the event, a written protest must be lodged before the signal to start the event is given.

15.2 Protests/appeals are possible if:

15.2.1 the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed;

15.2.2 there are conditions that endanger the competition and/or athletes, or

15.2.3 it is against a decision of a Judge

However, no protests/appeals shall be allowed against decisions of facts.

15.3 All protests must be considered by the Technical Delegate concerned who must make a decision as soon as possible. He/She must state the reason(s) for his/ her upholding/rejecting the protest.

15.4 Any Chef de Mission or Team Manager dissatisfied with the decision of the Technical Delegate, may appeal to the Jury of Appeal by submitting the written appeal to the TD within sixty (60) minutes of receipt of the TD's written decision. The appeal must be heard and decided by the Jury of Appeal for the sport within two (02) hours after receipt of the written protest.

15.5 Any NOC dissatisfied with any decision by the Jury of Appeal may make any appeal in accordance with Articles 42 and 43 of the SEAGF Charter and Rules.

15.6 The protest fee shall be refunded if the protest is upheld; it will be forfeited if the protest is rejected.
