INTRODUCTION OF THE CITY OF GÖDÖLLŐ

Gödöllő is a city of 32,000 people about 30km east of Budapest. It is often visited as a daytrip from Budapest.

The most notable attraction of the former royal holiday resort is the Baroque palace, named after its builder as the Grassalkovich Palace. It is a popular destination for those visiting Hungary largely due to the royal palace, former home of Emperor Franz Josef and Queen Elizabeth.

After visiting the palace, it is also worth visiting the nearby Elizabeth Park, where the statue of Queen Elizabeth by József Róna was inaugurated in 1901.



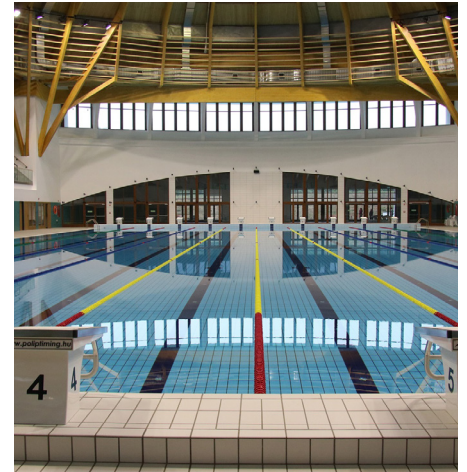
OFFICIAL COMPETITION POOL AND TRAINING FACILITY

The competition will take place at Gödöllő Municipal & Regional Swimming Pool.

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, 10 lanes and a depth of 2.2m. The temperature of the water is 26°C (+ 1°C). Warm up pool has a length of 25m.

The tribunes have the capacity of 600 people altogether.

The timekeeper will conduct time recording through an electronic time and recording system.



ACCOMMODATION

The accommodations are located in the centre of the University Campus in a landscaped area, next to the university sports venues surrounded with forest thus providing a tranquil environment yet it is still in the immediate vicinity of the city.

The centre of Gödöllő and the swimming pool is within only 10 minutes walking distance.

The capital city of Budapest can be easily reached in several ways: bus stops, railway and suburban railway stations are within 10 minutes walk and the trip takes 30 minutes. The hosting facility has shops, a pharmacy and buffet at the campus.

The main building offers hot buffet, a restaurant and university canteen. Those arriving by car can park for free next to the dormitory buildings.

The newly renovated 2-3 berths rooms are fitted with shower, toilet, fridge and a shared kitchen.



PARTICIPATION RELATED REGULATION

Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition. Each national team should respect the rules of championships, the safety conditions set by the organizers and CMAS rules and regulations.

Swimming-pool events:

- Each country may enter no more than two (2) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team.
- For relay races the names of the swimmers and their starting order must appear in a list submitted to the results office before the start of the session. The composition of mixed relays is with two (2) males and two (2) females and starting order is man – woman – man - woman. Any change in the fixed starting order leads to disqualification.
- It is possible to change the composition of the relay teams between the qualifying heats and the final.
- The entries must reach CMAS headquarters within the time limits set by the CMAS rules according to the procedure attached (www.cmasoffice.org and Sportsid – Sportdata).
- Continental Championships will be organized over four (4) days and eight (8) sessions.
- The qualifying heats are scheduled in the morning and finals in the afternoon except 400IM, 800SF and 1500SF slow heats in the morning and fast heat in the afternoon. For this reason, it's requested to the national federations to send to the CMAS HQ the official protocols of all selection national competitions in delay maximum of two weeks after the competitions (in one of the three CMAS languages).

Thus, times of enrolments of the swimmers will be checked for CMAS championships. If the protocols aren't transmitted in this deadline, times of corresponding enrolments will be cancelled, and the athletes will be engaged with time 59:59.99.

Bi Fins (BF): 50m, 100m, 200m, 400BF

BOTTLE FILLING

- Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed
- For pool competitions, the minimum volume of a compressed air cylinder (bottle) is liter 0.4 (zero point four liter)
- The maximum filling pressure for the compressed-air cylinders cannot exceed 200 bar (20 MPa).
- When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder is allowed
- All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if it is required by the local legislation.
- Each cylinder must be presented empty during checking meeting before competition.

The organizer guarantees the filling of DIN 200, YOKE, cylinders (bottles).

MISCELLANEOUS

National teams should bring two (2) national flags (m 2,00 x m. 1,25) and a CD with the national anthem (short version).

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BOOKING & ENTRY FEES

CMAS European Championship from 17 July 2023 to 23 July 2023

Entry fee per participant is **726 €**.

The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in university campus with double or triple hotel rooms full board.
- Free transfers between the official hotel and competition place (training day include).
- Providing of 2x0,5l drinking water per Pax/per day
- Participation at the closing ceremony (gala dinner).
- Full board accommodation is considered as breakfast, warm lunch, warm dinner and water drink 0,5l per meal included.

Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than official will have to pay **363 € / person** for secretarial fees, competition, opening and closing gala ceremony. No local transfers will be provided.

- Transfers from international airport to hotel and return extra fees 75 €/person
- Extra charges for single room 40 € /person/day.
- Extra day charged at 121€ /person/day, including full board accommodation (breakfast, lunch, dinner and water drink 0,5l per meal included).
- Training camp before championships – please contact the organizers for pool availability and conditions.

ATTENTION! Late registrations can not be accepted!

Minimum 50% of total entry fee should be deposited at our bank no later than May 15th to guarantee the booking. After this date the participation fees will increase by a further 10% of total amount. The remaining payment should be made until arrival. Completion of payment will be checked at registration.

Payment should be made by bank transfer. (Bank cheque and credit card will not be accepted)
