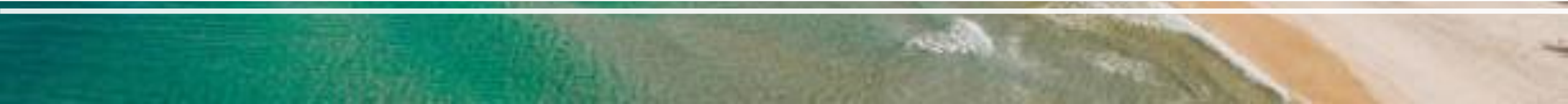

Australia is big –it covers an area of 7,741,220sqm km and is over 4000km wide and 3080km from top to bottom

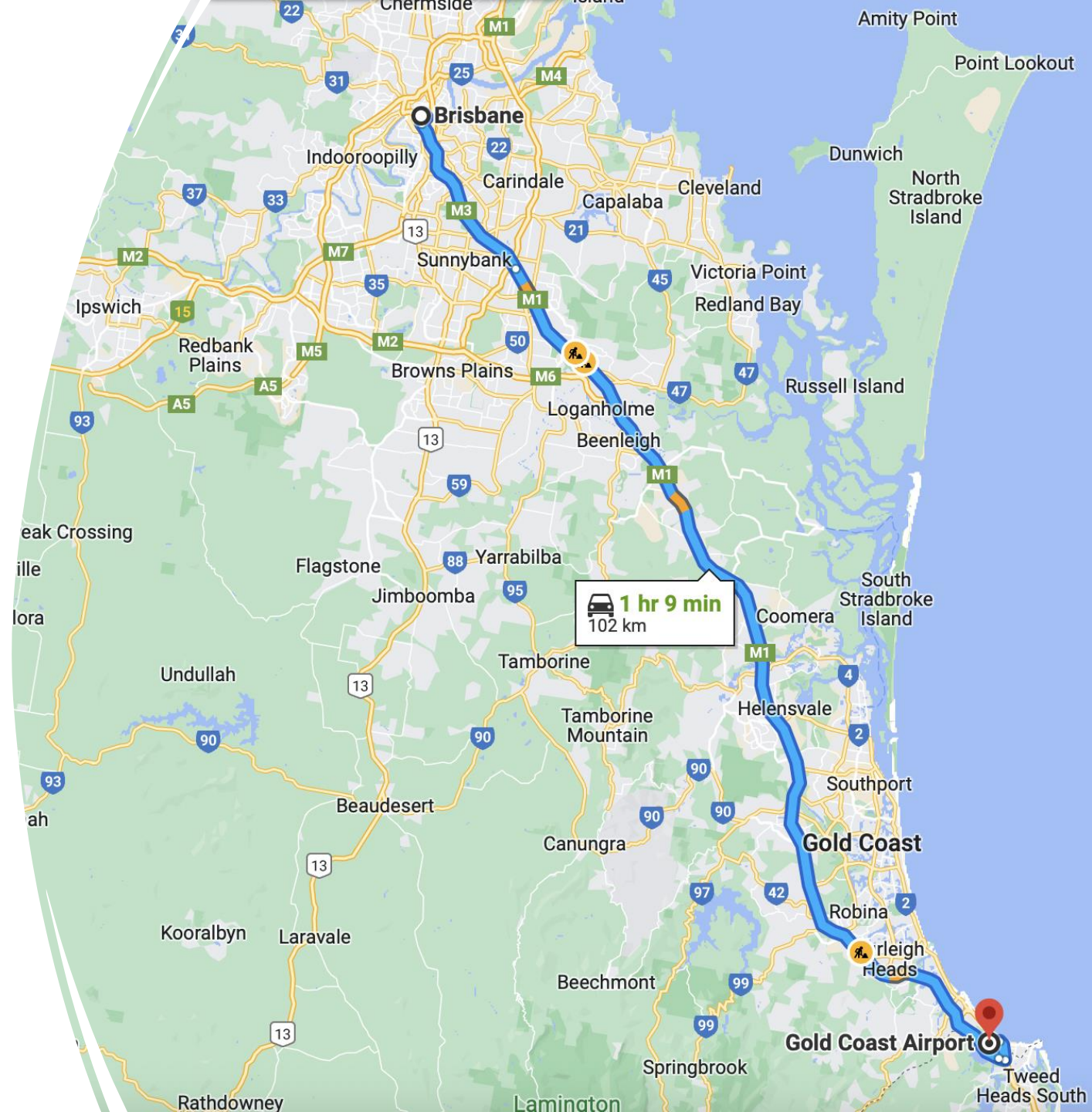
The Gold Coast is about mid-way on the eastern seaboard with a population of just over half a million people

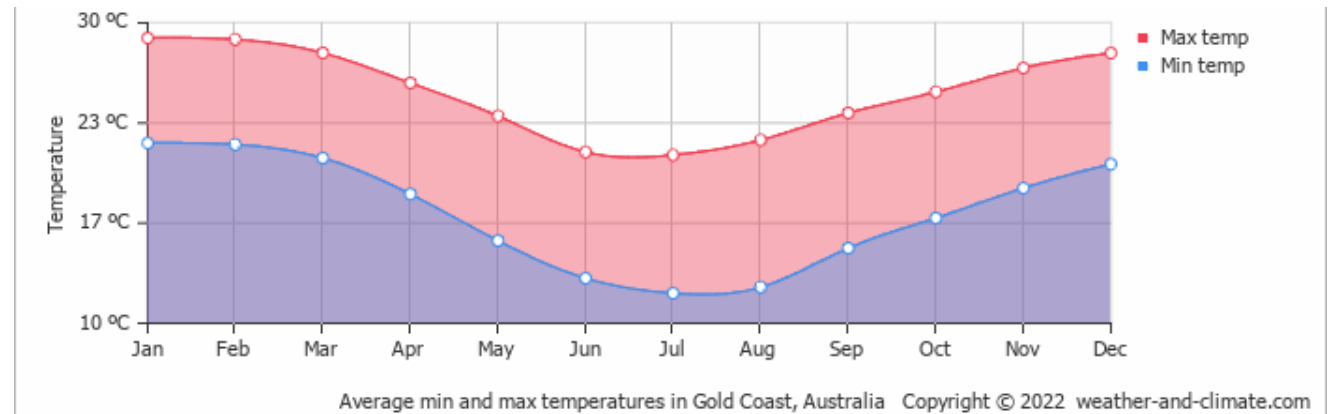
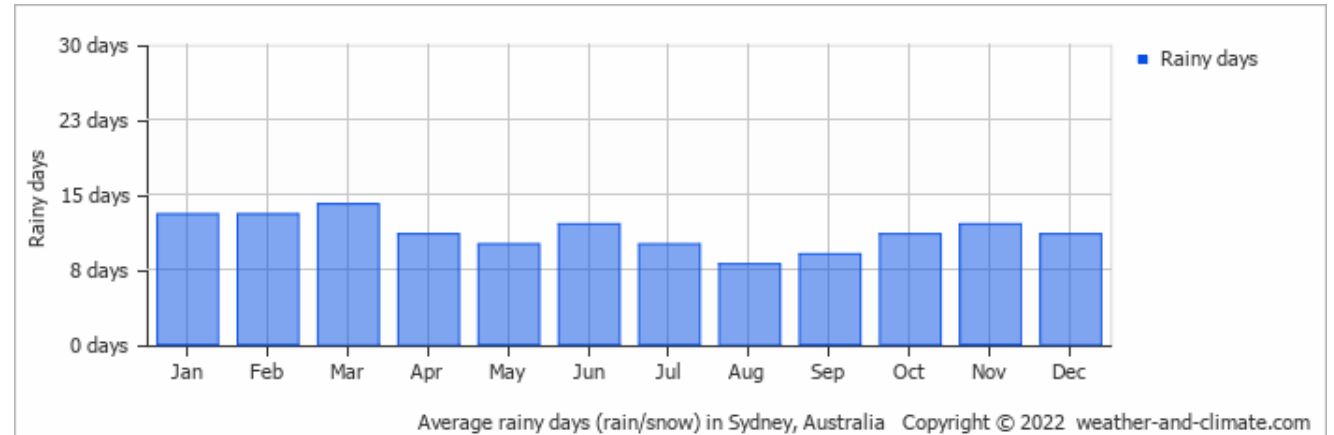
Getting there from overseas

- There are two major Airports when planning to get to the Gold Coast.
- Brisbane (BNE) is a little over an hours drive North of the Gold Coast and is a major international air hub. A major highway links Brisbane Airport to the Gold Coast
- Gold Coast Airport (OOL) is also an international airport closer to the pool but fewer flights land here. Due to Traffic and domestic roads the drive to the pool will take around 40 minutes.



Climate

- In the Southern Hemisphere it is Winter during the month of July however temperatures are mild. A jacket and some warmer clothes are recommended for the evenings.

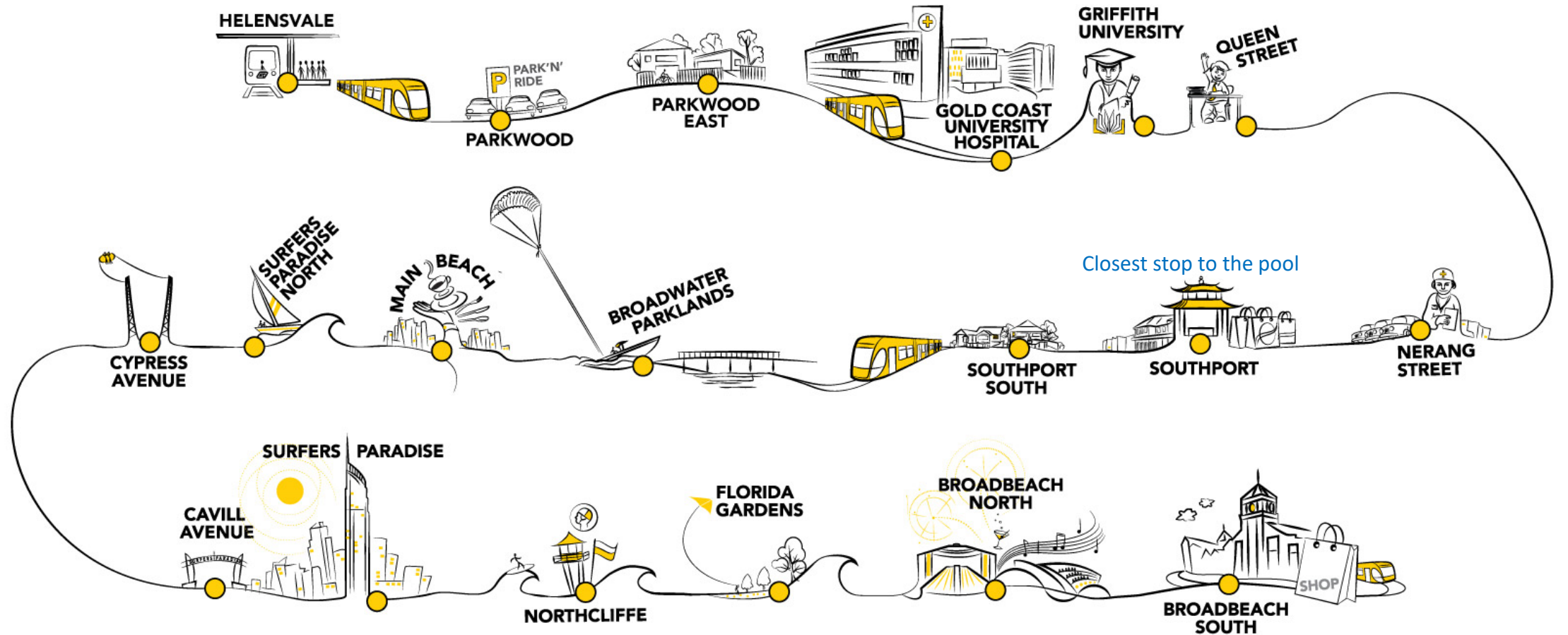


Local Transport

- The Gold Coast is a great place to walk, ride a bike or catch a Taxi. Taxi's are metered and you only pay the fare on the meter
- There are Buses and a local Light Rail Network that are good connections to the pool if your accommodation is close to their routes.



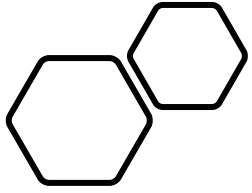
Light Rail Network



Driving in Australia

- Australians drive on the left hand side of the road and vehicles have the steering wheel on the right hand side.
- Speed limits are enforced and drivers must have a valid international drivers license.
- On the Gold Coast paid parking spaces are the main option and there are many inspectors so check the street signs and pay at the meter to avoid fines.





The Pool

- Gold Coast Aquatic Centre is an outdoor pool complex that has hosted major International Competitions.
- The 50m pool is 21m wide with a 2m depth. It will be set up to run two hockey courts playing across the pool
- There are metered car parking spaces around the pool with a café inside the pool complex

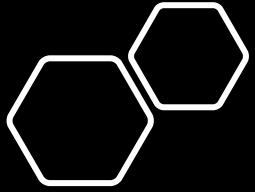
