OFFICIAL COMPETITION & TRAININGS

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

After Kazan (2013 – CMAS games), St Petersburg (2015 – World Championships), Tomsk (2020 – World Championships) and Fnideq, Morocco, here comes the 5th Sport Diving Senior, and 2nd Sport Diving Junior World Championship in Tartu.

The competition will take place in Tartu (Estonia) from the 09th to the 12th of August 2023.

Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition.

Each national team should respect the rules of the championships, the local organisers' (LOC's) safety conditions, and CMAS rules and regulations.

The entire event is rule by:

2. FLAGS

Every National team must bring with it two (2) national flags (m. 2,00 x m.1,00) and a USB flash drive with the national anthem (short version).

3. EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS & UNIFORMITY

The equipment and materials needed to participate the competition are the followings

4. PARTICIPATION

SWIMMING-POOL EVENTS:

Each country may register not more than two (2) swimmers for each individual distance, two (2) pair for each pair distance and one (1) relay team (i.e., 4 pax), by category (M-Male, F-Female + B-Boy, G-Girl and/or MX-Mixed).

If the relay team is mixed, it's composed of two female athletes and two male athletes. The starting order is free and is decided by the team leader.

There are only final heats scheduled in the morning and in the afternoon. For this reason, it's requested to the national federations to send to the CMAS HQ the official protocols of all national selection for competitions in delay maximum of two weeks after the selection competitions' (in one of the three CMAS languages).

The list of national records for athletes registering in competition (start list), should be sent to CMAS HQ and the organising committee.

Thus, times of enrolments of the swimmers will be checked for CMAS championships. If the protocols aren't transmitted in this deadline, times of corresponding enrolments will be cancelled, and the athletes will be engaged with time 00:00:00.

Each championship competition (Juniors / Seniors) is individual in 2 ages categories:

- "Seniors" : age group A, male & female from 18 years old
- "Juniors" : age group B+C+D, male & female between 12 and 17 years old.

(The athletic age of a competitor is obtained by subtracting his year of birth from the current year. The competitor will compete from January 1 until December 31 of the year in this category.)

No athlete is admitted taking part in a competition of an age category lower than his/her own age category.

An athlete is allowed to compete in a higher category but will be registered in this category for the entire event, except for the constitution of a relay team (i.e., 4 pax).

In that present case, the athlete will compete in this category only for the concerned relay.

5. Registration

- Payment of CMAS fees subscription already paid with your annual affiliation fees.
- You must order and pay the CMAS licences in www.cmasoffice.org. Soon the payment registered in CMAS Office, the licence is valid to register the athletes in SportsID/SportData (note that the payment by credit card is more useful because by transfer, it needs time before the money is credited on the CMAS account and do the licence valid).
- Register the athletes and the events in the platform SportsID/SportData according to the deadline in the last page and following the instructions in the procedure notice attached (ID Photo mandatory because the accreditations are printed from the platform).

11. DOPING CONTROL

12. CYLINDERS FILLING

- Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed
- Minimum size of bottle & maximum filling pressure according to CMAS Sport Diving rules:
MINIMUM volume of tanks is :
 - 5L for athletes who are 12-13 years old;
 - 7L for athletes who are 14-17 years old;
 - 10L for adult athletes who are 18 years old or more.
- LOC guarantees the filling of YOKE cylinders. (*Bottles equipped DIN could be available to National teams through a written booking request at the time of subscription and in which details about the quantity and wished volumes should be provided.*)
- 10L Cylinders can be provided by LOC (upon request, see below)
- The maximum filling pressure for the compressed-air cylinders cannot exceed 200 bar (20 MPa).
- All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if it is required by the local legislation.
- When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder, is allowed

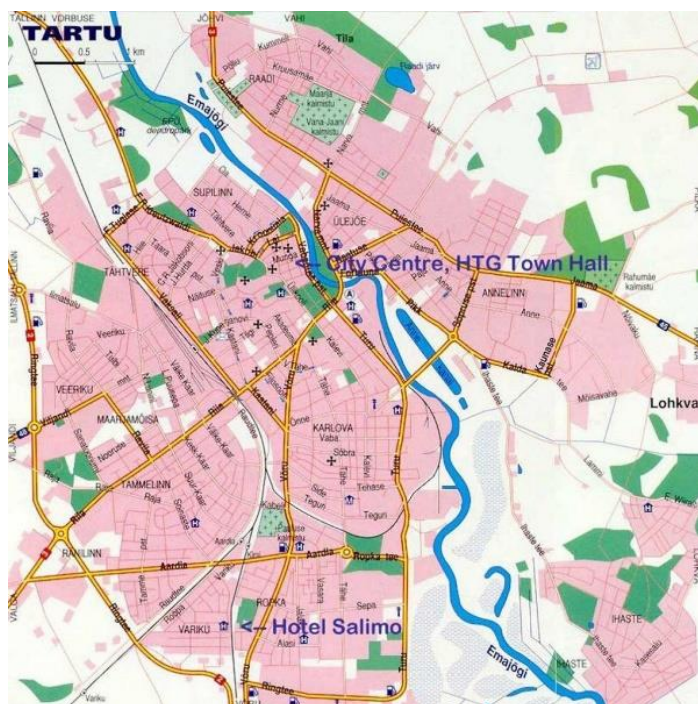

➔ 2h15min by bus/car ;

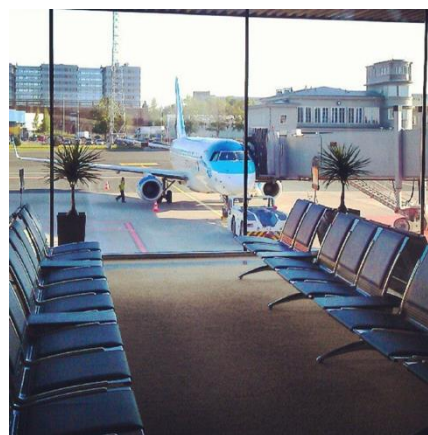


Time of travel from hotel to swimming-pool
of competition

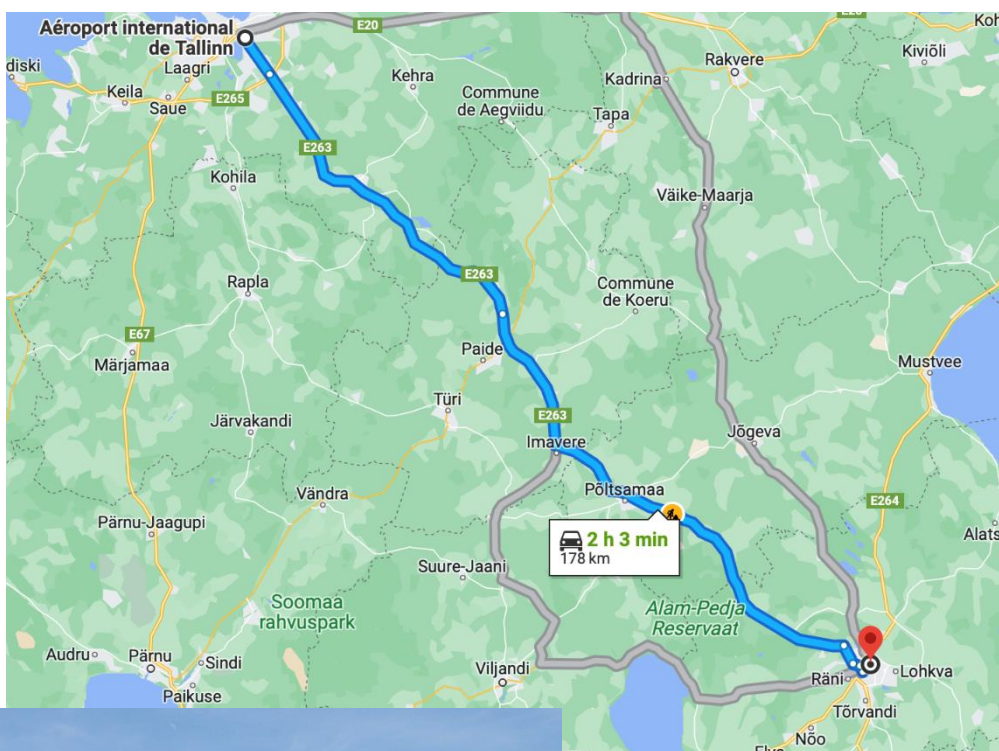

AURA KESKUS Swimming pool

Aura Centre has two swimming pools.

1. A 25 × 50 m swimming pool meeting international requirements. The depth of the pool is 1.2 m at the shallow end and 1.85 m at the deep end. The largest swimming pool in Estonia is intended for health athletes, active hobbyists, professional swimmers, and people interested in water aerobics. The pool is also well suited for sports competitions, including international competitions.

2. The 8 × 25 m training pool is intended for children's swimming lessons. The water temperature in this pool is 30 °C, the depth at is 60 cm the shallow end and 90 cm at the deep end. All visitors can use the training pool when swimming lessons are not taking place.

The swimming pool provides steam sauna.

The Tartu Olympic Swimming pool has installation and commissioning of timekeeping equipment to allow the realisation of international competitions, and complete equipment has been in place ; the 50m swimming pool dimensions are:

- 50 x 25 m,
- 50m pool depth : 1.2 m at the shallow end and 1.85 m at the deep end
- 10 Swimming Corridors ;
- 1 Boys & 1 Girls Changing Room and toilets.
