☐ Testing 2011

 Information provided to WADA on 2011 programme (81 tests – 5 events)

- Out-of-Competition: 5 tests

C.M.A.S Registered Testing Pool:6 top individual athletes (3 Men, 3 Women) in the Finswimming discipline

- Use of the online « ADAMS » system







☐ Testing 2012

- A total minimum of 35 In-competition tests at 7 events (Focus on Finswimming)
- A total of 20 Out-of-Competition tests prior to Finswimming and Apnoea events

- C.M.A.S Registered Testing Pool:
- 2 -3 tests all along the year, including blood testing







☐ Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs)

- Administration by SportAccord DFSU
- C.M.A.S. TUE Commission includes 3 members - chaired by Dr. Léglise.
- New: use of the ADAMS system (facilitates the mandatory reports to WADA)
- New: recognitition of TUEs granted by National Anti-Doping Organizatins (NADOs)







☐ Results Management

 Initial Review of potential violations by SportAccord DFSU, on behalf of the C.M.A.S.Secretary General

C.M.A.S. Doping Hearing Panel (DHP): a
 Chair + 5 Members. Upon each case the
 Chair nominates a Doping Hearing
 Chamber (DHC) of 3 persons

 Appeals to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) or national level appeal body depending on the level of the athlete
