1. ORGANIZER

The tournament is organized by the UNDERWATER-RUGBY-TEAM of the STC GRAZ.

2. VENUE/ TIME

The tournament takes place on Saturday, 29th of June 2013, at the new swimming pool "Auster" in Eggenberg in the city of Graz:

4. STARTING FEE

5. TEAMS/ COMPETITORS

One team consists of 12 players and 3 substitutes.

At most 12 teams are allowed to take part in this tournament. (the PANTHERs of the STC GRAZ included) Representative teams and player communities from different teams are also accepted.

6. RULES

The official rules of the CMAS are valid during the tournament. The play mode and duration of games depend on the number of the teams taking part in the competition. The sequence of games will be defined at the conference of the team leaders.

7. PLAYING AREA

The tournament will take in the outdoor diving pool with the following measurements:

Length: 16 m Width: 10 m Depth: 5 m

8. REFEREE

Every team has to have two referees with a valid license for the current year.

A fee of 25,- € will be charged for every missing referee.

9. ADMINISTRATION OF THE TOURNAMENT

The administration will consist of one representative of the home team and two representatives from other teams who will be elected at the team leaders meeting.

10. PROTESTS

Protests have to be placed up to 30 minutes after the match on paper by the team captain at the administration.

11. PRESENTATION CEREMONY

The presentation ceremony is held directly after the last game at at the swimming pool. Afterwards there will be possibility to enjoy a dinner together at a restaurant in walking distance at your own costs. The exact address of the restaurant and if there will be a buffet or a à la Carte Menu will be announced prior to the tournament.

12. LIABILITY

The teams participate at their own risk.

The organizer and the administration don't accept any liability.

13. CUP

The winner of the tournament will keep the challenge cup "The Styrian Panther" until the next tournament. If a team wins the tournament for three consecutive years the cup will become permanent property of this team.
